

BAY COUNTY LONG-DISTANCE PARENTING TIME POLICY SCHEDULE D

This is a long-distance parenting time policy (travel distance of over 150 miles one-way) for child(ren) upon completion of kindergarten.

This schedule shall be followed unless otherwise mutually agreed upon in writing, signed by both parties and submitted to the Friend of the Court office.

1. The non-custodial parent shall have the spring school vacation in odd-numbered years. Spring school break is defined as 6 p.m. the day school recesses until 6 p.m. the day before school resumes.
2. The non-custodial parent shall have the first half of the summer school vacation in even-numbered years and the second half of summer vacation in the odd-numbered years. Summer vacation is defined as 9 a.m. two days after school recesses for the school year until 6 p.m. two days before the new school year resumes. Summer school necessary for the child(ren) to pass to the next grade must be attended. A general itinerary shall be provided to the other parent if the child(ren) are on a trip away from either parent's home.
3. The non-custodial parent shall have the Thanksgiving holiday in even-numbered years. Thanksgiving shall be defined as 6 p.m. on Wednesday until 6 p.m. on Sunday.
4. The non-custodial parent shall have the Christmas school vacation in odd-numbered years. Christmas school vacation is defined as 6 p.m. the day school recesses until 6 p.m. the day before school resumes.
5. Responsibility for transportation costs for spring, summer, Thanksgiving, and Christmas parenting time shall be shared equally, i.e., the parent receiving the child(ren) shall be responsible for picking the child(ren) up from the other parent's residence, the parties shall meet at an agreeable mid-way point, the parent receiving the child(ren) shall provide for one way airline ticket, or the cost for round-trip airfare shall be split equally.
6. Additional parenting time upon a minimum of seven days' advanced, written notice whenever the non-custodial parent is in the geographical area of the child(ren).
7. Whenever the child(ren) are in the area of non-custodial parent, the custodial parent must notify the non-custodial parent and offer time for the child(ren) to be with that parent.
8. The non-custodial parent shall have weekend parenting time whenever the child(ren) have a Friday or a Monday school holiday. The non-custodial parent shall be solely responsible for transportation during these parenting time periods. The custodial parent shall provide a copy of the school calendar to the non-custodial parent every fall so that arrangements for extended weekend parenting time can be made in advance.
9. During periods of extended parenting time with the non-custodial parent, the child support abatement shall not be affected by regularly scheduled parenting time periods with the custodial parent. For example, during extended summer parenting time, weekend parenting time with the custodial parent shall not affect the abatement.
