- WHEREAS, The State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) is the administrative agency of the Michigan Supreme Court and is responsible for administering the Federal Access and Visitation Grants to courts for the provision of direct services that increase non-custodial parents' access to and visitation with their children;
- WHEREAS, The SCAO is contracting with the Bay County Friend of the Court for the provision of direct services that support and facilitate non-custodial parents' access to and visitation with their children; and
- WHEREAS, The direct Service Provider Agency for the Bay County Friend of the Court is the Lutheran Child & Family Service which will provide supervised parenting time based on Court Order referrals from the Friend of the Court office; and
- WHEREAS, Supervised (including monitored and therapeutic) parenting time is eligible for reimbursement through contractual agreement; and
- WHEREAS, The total Access and Visitation funding available to the Bay County Friend of the Court is \$2,300.00, the FY 2012 allocation was \$2,200, an increase for FY 2013 of \$100. This number is based upon the available budget by the State of Michigan; Therefore, Be It
- RESOLVED By the Bay County Board of Commissioners that the FY 2013 Federal Access and Visitation Grant is approved and the Chairman of the Board is authorized to execute the grant and related documents as well as contracts pertaining to the Federal Access and Visitation Grant following legal review/approval; Be It Further

- WHEREAS, Bay County has been studying options for electronic document systems in the Prosecutor's Office for the past several months as a method to increase efficiency and reduce costs; and
- WHEREAS, Other court-related departments are interested as well and the system must be compatible with those units; and
- WHEREAS, Plante & Moran has done electronic document management/workflow/software analysis studies for a number of other counties in Michigan to include Genesee, Muskegon, Ottawa and Washtenaw; and
- WHEREAS, Based on Plante & Moran's level of experience, County Administration is requesting that exemption # 7 from the County's Purchasing Policy Large Purchases Competitive Sealed bids be allowed; and
- WHEREAS, Exemption # 7 allows for an exemption "in the procurement of consultant, advisory, or other professional services as identified by the Bay County Board of Commissioners."; and
- WHEREAS, Plante & Moran has indicated that the fee for these services will not exceed \$30,000, however, a budget adjustment from General Fund fund balance to the Information Systems Division budget is necessary as this expense was not budgeted; Therefore, Be It
- RESOLVED That the Bay County Board of Commissioners approves an exemption from the bid process of the Bay County Purchasing Policy for the purpose of hiring Plante & Moran to conduct a document management, workflow analysis and imaging software selection process for the Prosecutor and Court System; Be It Further
- RESOLVED That authorization is granted to enter into a contract with Plante & Moran for document management, workflow analysis and imaging software services for the Prosecutor and Court System and the Chairman of the Board is authorized to execute said contract on behalf of Bay County following legal review/approval; Be It Finally

BY: WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE (11/13/12)
 WHEREAS, There has been much discussion about the current financial status of the Bay County Golf Course for more than a year; and
 WHEREAS, Fund balance has been seriously depleted and revenues are not keeping pace with operating expenses; and
 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Clubhouse Supervisor along with Recreation Division staff has prepared a preliminary plan based on the guidance in a book entitled "The Business of Golf - What are you thinking?" authored by James J. Keegan; and
 WHEREAS, James J. Keegan is a golf business consultant who has worked throughout the nation and beyond for over twenty years, including recent business plans for Currie Golf Courses in Midland owned by the City of Midland and for the City of Ann Arbor golf courses with much of his focus being on publicly-owned courses and their unique advantages and challenges; and
 WHEREAS, While it was not felt Bay County could afford to hire Mr. Keegan to prepare a plan from scratch, the point has been reached where County Administration is struggling for solutions that produce meaningful changes in a positive direction on the balance sheet; and
 WHEREAS, The timing is appropriate to hire Mr. Keegan to review the draft plan and offer his recommendations given that there has been discussion of a significant operating transfer from the General Fund; and
 WHEREAS, The Finance Officer has advised that the only way to maintain operations in the near term will require an infusion of cash from the General Fund; and
 WHEREAS, While earlier in 2012 Administration explored the possibility of a full-time staff reduction, it was withdrawn due to course quality concerns not because the financial picture has improved; and
 WHEREAS, Given the need for operating funds, if Mr. Keegan is engaged to perform this review it will have to be paid by the General Fund in an amount not to exceed \$19,250 which includes travel expenses, meals, lodging, a local market analysis, weather playable days, technology review, financial bench marking, model and yield management as well as an extensive golfer survey; and
 WHEREAS, County Administration recommends in favor of hiring Mr. Keegan feeling it is worthwhile and a wise investment given Mr. Keegan's expertise in the golf industry but acknowledging that there is no guarantee on the outcome; Therefore, Be It
 RESOLVED That the Bay County Board of Commissioners authorizes contracting with James Keegan and Associates for a business plan review and recommendations for the Bay County Golf Course for a fee not to exceed \$19,250 which includes travel expenses, meals, lodging, a local market analysis, weather playable days, technology review, financial bench marking, model and yield management as well as an extensive golfer survey and the Chairman of the Board of is authorized to execute the contract and related documents with James Keegan and Associates on behalf of Bay County following legal review/approval; Be It Further
 RESOLVED That a budget adjustment from General Fund fund balance to the Golf Course fund is approved.

1. Sheriff, we are going to have a budget shortfall in the kitchen of approximately \$31,000 for this calendar year.
2. Our shortage results from both the increase in inmate population and the increase in cost for food, non-food items, and laundry chemicals.
3. During the first 9 months of 2012 our daily inmate population was up 6% (13 inmates per day) over the same period in 2011.
4. The cost of food, non-food items, and laundry chemicals has increased 10-12% from the previous year.
4. The average food cost for an inmate (3 meals) per day in 2011 was \$3.20. The average food cost for an inmate (3 meals) per day in 2012 is \$3.57.

WHEREAS, Bay Health Plan is a non-profit corporation whose purposes include promoting, organizing, managing, and administering programs to create a system of providing or arranging health care services for persons who are not covered under other public or private health care programs; and

WHEREAS, The BHP Corporation contracts under a separate agreement with certain hospitals to establish a program of health care service for certain persons for who health care is not available; and

WHEREAS, The Health Department provides and arranges for the provision of health care services as part of its programs and the County provides HIPAA compliant office space to BHP at BCHD; and

WHEREAS, An amendment to the Agreement originally entered into on 10/1/2004 has been submitted which will extends th term of the Agreement for three (3) years commencing 10/1/2012 and expiring 9/30/2015 unless amended by either party; and

WHEREAS, All other terms and conditions of the Agreement and Exhibits remain in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, The County sends intergovernmental transfers to the State of Michigan to support Indigent Care Agreement Pools. These funds are being leveraged to increase health care funding in the community and the hospital will receive a total payment of \$2.30 for every \$1.00 sent to the state; and

WHEREAS, The Bay Health Plan Corporation compensates the County for services rendered under this Agreement on a quarterly basis from 10/1/2012 through 9/30/2015 and Bay County will receive \$3,500 per year from 10/1/2012 through 9/30/2015 from the Bay Health Plan for office space, computer equipment, internet, and email access, office furniture, miscellaneous support for office operation (copier, fax); Therefore, Be It
