- WHEREAS, On April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012, Army Staff Sergeant Travis Mills of the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne was severely injured by an improvised explosive device (IED) during his third tour of duty in Afghanistan, resulting in the loss of both arms and legs; and
- WHEREAS, Army Staff Sergeant Mills is believed to be only the fourth quadruple amputee in U.S. military history to survive his injuries and he is currently undergoing intense medical treatment, to include multiple surgeries, at the Walter Reed Army Medical Center in Washington, D.C.; and
- WHEREAS, Travis, a native of Vassar, his wife, Kelsey, and their four month old daughter, Chloe, are now faced with a long road to recovery and their lives have been forever impacted by the injuries he sustained in service to our nation; and
- WHEREAS, The Vassar community, indeed the entire nation, has come together to provide prayer and a helping hand to the Mills' family to help ease the emotional and financial burden during this difficult time; and
- WHEREAS, The Richville American Legion is hosting a Memorial Day weekend spaghetti dinner fundraiser for Travis on Sunday, May 27<sup>th</sup> from 2 pm to 7 pm at the Alvin F. Miller Hall, 9890 Sanilac Road, Richville including a bake sale and a live auction at 4 pm; Therefore, Be It

WHEREAS, The Bay County Board of Commissioners and the Bay County Executive wish to take this opportunity to honor Trenton Robinson who realized his dream when the San Francisco 49ers made him the 10<sup>th</sup> pick of the sixth round of the 2012 NFL Draft; and

WHEREAS, Trenton Robinson, a 2007 graduate from Central High School and a three year starter, becomes the first person from Bay City to be drafted into the NFL since 1973 when Jerry List was taken by the Oakland Raiders in the 11<sup>th</sup> round out of Nebraska and the first Bay City Central player to be drafted by the NFL since Dennis Wirgowski in 1970; and

WHEREAS, After an exemplary football career at Bay City Central, Trenton Robinson went on to great achievements at Michigan State including four-year letterwinner as free safety, 229 tackles, nine interceptions and 12 pass break-ups in 46 career games with 32 starts; and

WHEREAS, Trenton Robinson tied for 12<sup>th</sup> in program history with nine interceptions; and

WHEREAS, Trenton Robinson was a two-time All-Big Ten selection for the Spartans and a team tri-captain as a senior and his class became only the fourth in program history to have never lost to Michigan; and

WHEREAS, As a senior, Trenton Robinson was named to the Jim Thorpe Award watch list finishing third on the team with 80 tackles and, as a junior, was named Big Ten Defensive Player for the Week against Michigan after recording seven tackles, an interception and a pass break-up; and

WHEREAS, Other All-Time Draft picks from Bay City include 1956: Jarv Walz (Bay City Central/CMU) - Lions - 24<sup>th</sup> round; 1957: Jerry Leahy (St. Joseph/Colorado - Lions - 7<sup>th</sup> round; 1963: Jim Kanicki (Bay City Central/MSU) - Browns - 2<sup>nd</sup> round; 1966: Rick Czap (Bay City Central/Nebraska) - Browns - 12<sup>th</sup> round; 1968: Wayne Meylan (Bay City Handy/Nebraska) - Browns - 4<sup>th</sup> round; and 1970: Dennis Wirgowski (Bay City Central/Purdue) - Patriots 9<sup>th</sup> round; Therefore, Be It
