

SUBJECT: Part Time Account Clerk

Request: Establish a part time account clerk, TS-05 \$11.60 per hour entry progressing to \$13.72 after 6 years, to be shared between the Homeland Security, Housing Rehabilitation and Animal Control Divisions of the Recreation and Administrative Services Department.

Background: Bay County serves as fiduciary for the fourteen county Region 3 Homeland Security Planning Board. There are presently several grants in progress nearing or executing ten million dollars.

The fiscal work is presently carried out by Patricia Bostick a full time employee funded one hundred percent by these grants and a part time accountant (up to 20 hours per week) also funded exclusively by Homeland Security funds. Limited clerical assistance has been received from the account clerk in the Finance Department, with reimbursement through the grant for those hours spent on Homeland Security grant administration.

It has been apparent for sometime that Ms. Bostick is in need of greater administrative support for the myriad financial duties she is responsible for, and funds are available in the grants to pay for this.

At the same time, the Board and Administration have been discussing the re-establishment of Saturday morning hours at the Bay County Animal Shelter. This position had to be discontinued when the elimination of a part time typist clerk occurred in 2010. The Board has received numerous signed petitions seeking Saturday shelter hours. It would be possible to allocate four hours per week of this position to the Animal Shelter to open

from 9:00 a.m to 1:00 p.m. on Saturdays.

Similarly, a limited amount of administrative support is currently provided to the Purchasing Agent/Housing Rehab Coordinator by the Finance Department, Administrative Assistant. Up to four hours per week of the position would be allocated to Housing Rehab which is a MSHDA grant of federal Community Development Block Grant funds with a percentage for administration, and any Homeland Security purchasing is reimbursable by the Homeland Security Grants.

Economics: A part time account clerk is classified as a TS-05, USWA part time unit with current wage of \$11.60 per hour progressing to \$13.72 per hour. This position would be shared by divisions within Recreation and Administrative Services as follows:

Homeland Security	21 hours per week
Housing Rehab	4 hours per week
Animal Control	4 hours per week (appropriation from fund balance)

Sufficient funds are available within the various grants to cover 25 of the 29 hours per week. Total annual cost for the first year is \$20,597.77, of which \$17,756.70, is grant and \$2,841.07 is general funds. The Animal Control Saturday hours will require an appropriation of \$2,841.07. from general fund balance for Saturday operation of the Animal Shelter.

At such time as grant funds are no longer available the position will have hours reduced accordingly.

Recommendation: Authorize the creation of a part time account clerk, TS-05, USWA part time unity shared between Homeland Security (21 hours per week), Housing Rehab (4 hours per week), and Animal Control (4 hours per week on Saturdays), authorize the position to be posted and filled.





1992-2011 Total Case Appointments




