

BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS  
RECOUNT OF BEAVER TOWNSHIP TREASURER  
SEPTEMBER 13, 2000

THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS MET ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2000, AT 9:00 A.M., IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM ON THE FOURTH FLOOR OF THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING FOR THE RECOUNT OF VOTES CAST FOR THE OFFICE OF BEAVER TOWNSHIP TREASURER IN THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD AUGUST 8, 2000. CANDIDATES WERE DONNA FEKETE, ROBERT R. MIESKE, AND NICHOLAS SCOTT TOMCZAK. THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS WERE PRESENT FOR THE RECOUNT PROCEDURE:

BOARD MEMBER DON CHEVALIER ANNOUNCED THAT THE BALLOT CAN HAD BEEN SEALED WITH SEAL NO. 773884. THE SEAL WAS BROKEN AND BALLOTS INSPECTED. IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THERE WERE NO DEFECTIVE BALLOTS. THERE WERE SPOILED BALLOTS, AND ALL THOSE VOTERS WERE EITHER GIVEN A NEW BALLOT OR THE BALLOT HAD BEEN DUPLICATED. THERE WERE 722 BALLOTS TO BE COUNTED, WHICH MATCHED THE NUMBER IN THE POLL BOOK.

DURING THE COUNT OF THE BALLOTS, IT WAS NOTICED THAT ONE BALLOT HAD BEEN CROSS-VOTED; THEREFORE, THE VOTES WOULD NOT COUNT FOR THE CANDIDATES, BUT THE VOTES WOULD COUNT FOR THE PROPOSALS AND THE JUDGE'S RACE. THE VOTE ON THIS BALLOT FOR THE BEAVER TOWNSHIP TREASURER WAS NOT TALLIED. THE PREVIOUSLY COUNTED BALLOTS WERE REVEIUED, AND ONE MORE CROSS-VOTED BALLOT WAS DISCOVERED. THE VOTE ON THAT BALLOT FOR THE TREASURER'S OFFICE WAS REMOVED FROM THE TALLY.

ALL BALLOTS WERE COUNTED WITH NO CHALLENGES. THE TOTAL VOTES WERE 213 FOR FEKETE, 212 FOR MIESKE, AND 167 FOR TOMCZAK. THE CAN WAS RESEALED WITH SEAL NO. 768999.
