TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF
BAY COUNTY, MICHIGAN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Primary Election will be held in the County of Bay, State of Michigan on Tuesday, August 2, 2016 at which time candidates of the Republican Party and Democratic Party seeking nomination to the following partisan offices, nonpartisan offices and ballot questions are to be voted for. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time.

Proposals:

The following is a summary of the six (6) millage proposals which shall be considered on the August 2, 2016 ballot:

Fraser Township Millage Renewal Proposal

Renewal of 1.0 mill for four (4) years, December 1, 2016 through December 1, 2019 for the construction, maintenance and improvement of local public roads in Fraser Township.

Fraser Township Fire Millage Renewal Proposal

Renewal of 1.0 mill for the period of four (4) years, December 1, 2016 through December 1, 2019 for the purpose of operating the township fire department, maintaining the fire hall and purchasing necessary firefighting equipment for Fraser Township.

Merritt Township Road Millage Proposal

Should Merritt Township levy up to 1.5 mills for five (5) years, December 1, 2018 through December 1, 2022, for revenue for maintenance and improvement of public roads in Merritt Township, a renewal of the prior millage expiring December 1, 2017.

Monitor Township Fire/Police Millage Renewal

Charter Township of Monitor 0.75 mill reduced to 0.7494 mill by the required millage rollback, be renewed and levied for ten (10) years commencing 2016 through 2025 inclusive, to provide supplemental funding for the Monitor Township Fire Department, including purchase of new firefighting vehicles and equipment, and for Sheriff patrol services.

Mt. Forest Township Fire Department Protection Millage Renewal

Renewal of an amount not to exceed 1.47mills for a period of nine (9) years, 2016 to 2024, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for operating, equipping and purchasing for the Mt. Forest Township fire department and any other fire related purpose.

Freeland Community School District Millage Renewal Proposal Building/Site Sinking Fund

Authorization for the school district to continue to levy the building and site sinking fund millage that expires with the 2016 tax levy. Renewal for eight (8) years, 2017 to 2024 for the purchase of real estate and the construction/repair of school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law.
