

**NOTICE OF ELECTION
TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS
OF BAY COUNTY, MICHIGAN
TUESDAY, MAY 5, 2015**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an Election will be held in the County of Bay, State of Michigan on Tuesday, May 5, 2015 at which time the following proposal is to be voted for. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m to 8:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time.

Proposal:

The following is a summary of the one (1) state proposal which shall be considered on the May 5, 2015 ballot:

STATEWIDE PROPOSAL 15-1

A proposal to amend the State Constitution to increase the sales/use tax from 6% to 7% to replace and supplement reduced revenue to the School Aid Fund and local units of government caused by the elimination of the sales/use tax on gasoline and diesel fuel for vehicles operating on public roads, and to give effect to laws that provide additional money for roads and other transportation purposes by increasing the gas tax and vehicle registration fees.
