

**NOTICE OF LAST DAY TO REGISTER
ELECTORS OF ESSEXVILLE-HAMPTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS
BAY COUNTY, MICHIGAN
FEBRUARY 24, 2015 SCHOOL ELECTION**

All electors of Essexville-Hampton Public Schools are hereby given notice that a School Election will be held in the County of Bay, State of Michigan on Tuesday, February 24, 2015 at which time the following proposals shall be voted:

Essexville-Hampton Public Schools Proposals

The following is a summary of the two (2) Essexville-Hampton Public Schools proposals which shall be considered on the February 24, 2015 ballot:

- I. Essexville-Hampton Public Schools general obligation unlimited tax bond proposal for building and site purposes in the amount of not to exceed \$4,970,000.
- II. Essexville-Hampton Public Schools sinking fund millage for building and site purposes 3 mills for 5 years.

Please take further notice that the bonds of the school district, if approved by a majority vote of the electors at this election, will be general obligation unlimited tax bonds payable from general ad valorem taxes.

Electors who wish to vote in the School Election must be registered to vote no later than Monday, January 26, 2015 by 5:00 p.m. in accordance with Michigan Compiled Law 168.498. Persons who will attain the age of 18 years by election day, may also register prior to the deadline.

To register in person, visit your Township, City or County Clerk's office, Secretary of State Branch office, Michigan Office of Human Services, Department of Community Health, the Michigan Jobs Commissioner or any Military Recruitment Center.

Register by mail by obtaining and completing a Mail-In Voter Registration Application and forwarding it to the election officials as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline, Monday, January 26, 2015 by 5:00 p.m. Mail in registration forms may be requested from the Bay County Clerk or online at www.michigan.gov/sos

Electors who wish to register to vote or change their registration address are advised to contact their Township, City or County Clerk for office hours and other information.
