

**KERR-JAMMER-SZYMANSKI DRAIN
BAY COUNTY, MICHIGAN**

**NOTICE OF LETTING OF DRAIN CONTRACT
AND DAY OF REVIEW OF APPORTIONMENTS**

NOTICE IS NOW GIVEN, that I, Joseph Rivet, Drain Commissioner for the County of Bay and State of Michigan, at the Office of the Bay County Drain Commissioner, Bay County Building, 515 Center Ave., Suite 601 Bay City, MI, 48708 will receive sealed bids until 10:00 a.m., local time, on Tuesday, September 16, 2014, when bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the construction of a certain drain known and designated as the Kerr-Jammer-Szymanski Drain, located and established in the Township of Kawkawlin, in said County.

In construction of said drain and pump station, the following approximate quantities and type of pipe, along with appurtenances, will be required and a contract let for the same:

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at **10:00 AM on Thursday of September 4, 2014** at the office of the Bay County Drain Commissioner, Bay County Building, 515 Center Ave., Suite 601, Bay City, MI, 48708. It is a requirement that any prospective bidder attend this meeting. Representatives of the Owner and Professional will be present to discuss the project. **Attendance is required for sealed bids to be accepted.** The Professional will transmit to all prospective bidders of record an Addendum as the Professional considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.

Contracts will be made with the lowest responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work in the sum as specified in the bidding documents, reserving to myself the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn such bid letting to such time and place as I shall publicly announce.

The date for completion of such contract, and the terms of payment are contained in the contract specifications. Any responsible person wanting to bid on the above-mentioned work will be required to deposit Bid Surety in the amount specified in the bidding documents as a guarantee that they will enter into a Contract and furnish the required bonds as prescribed by the contract specifications and applicable law. All bids shall remain open for one hundred twenty (120) days after the day of the bid opening, but I reserve the right at my sole discretion to release any bid and bid security before that date.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that on Tuesday, October 14, 2014, at the Office of the Bay County Drain Commissioner, Bay County Building, 515 Center Ave., Suite 601 Bay City, MI, 48708, Michigan or at such time and place thereafter, to which I, the Bay County Drain Commissioner or my designated representative may adjourn the same, a day of review will be conducted to review tentative apportionments for benefits received and lands comprised within the Kerr-Jammer-Szymanski Drain and said tentative apportionments and lands will be subject to review on said day from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. local time.

At the meeting to review the apportionment of benefits, the Drain Commissioner will have available to review the tentative apportionments against parcels and municipalities within the drainage district. The computation of cost of construction of the Drain will also be open for public inspection by any parties interested.

The drain assessments against land in the drainage district will be collected in the same manner as property taxes. If the drain assessments against land are collected by installment, the landowner may pay the assessments in full with any interest to date at any time and thereby avoid further interest charges. Please contact the office of the Bay County Drain Commissioner with any questions about payments of drain assessments.

Pursuant to Section 155 of the Michigan Drain Code of 1956, as amended, any owner of land within the special assessment district for the KERR-JAMMER-SZYMANSKI DRAIN or any municipality aggrieved by the apportionments of benefits made by the Drain Commissioner may, within ten (10) calendar days of October 14, 2014, make application to the Bay County Probate Court for appointment of a Board of Review.

The following is a condensed description of the land constituting the Kerr-Jammer-Szymanski Drain Drainage District. The description of area that is served by the Kerr-Jammer-Szymanski Drain consists of lands situated in Sections 9, 10, 14, 15, 16, 22, & 23 of Kawkawlin Township, T.15N.-R.04E., Bay County, Michigan.

- In Section 9 - The Southwest ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of the Southwest ¼ and the South ½ of the South ½ and the Northeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of the Section.
- In Section 10 - The South ½ and the South ½ of the South ½ of the Northwest ¼ and the Northeast ¼ of the Section.
- In Section 14 - The West ½ if the West ½ of the Southwest ¼ of the Southwest ¼ of the Section.
- In Section 15 - The North ½ and the Southeast ¼ and the East ½ of the East ½ of the Southwest ¼ and the North ½ of the North ½ of the Southwest ¼ of the Section.



NOW THEREFORE, all owners and persons interested in the above-described special assessment district are hereby notified that, at the time and place aforesaid, or at such time and place thereafter to which said bid letting may be adjourned, I shall proceed to receive bids for the construction of the KERR-JAMMER-SZYMANSKI DRAIN, in the manner hereinbefore stated, and, also, that at such time and place as stated above from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. local time, the apportionment of benefits for the lands comprised within KERR-JAMMER-SZYMANSKI DRAIN special assessment district will be subject to review.

Proceedings conducted at the pre-bid conference, bid opening and day of review are subject to the Michigan Open Meetings Act. AND YOU AND EACH OF YOU, owners and persons interested in the aforesaid lands and Public Corporations are cited to appear at the time and place of such bid letting and day of review of apportionments aforesaid, and be heard with respect to such special assessments and your interests in relation thereto, if you so desire.

The review of apportionments is consistent with Section 154 of the Michigan Drain Code of 1956, as amended.
