Economic Development ~ Bay County Allocates Renosol \$3.1 Million in Federal Recovery Zone Facility Bonds

During the Board of Commissioner's meeting on Tuesday, Bay County granted Renosol Corporation a \$3.1 million federal recovery zone facility bond allocation. This funding is available through federal bonds from the America Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 to assist commercial and industrial projects.



Renosol wants to re-equip their facility and by doing so will bring in 125 jobs to its Portsmouth Township location within the next 5 years.
