



Michigan Green Schools Program Frequently Asked Questions . . .

1. When is my school's application to become a Michigan Green School due?

All applications are due on March 1, 2013.

2. How many points of green activities do we need to qualify?

Ten points with at least two points from each of the four activity categories are required to gain official Michigan Green School status.

3. Are there higher awards?

Yes, schools achieving fifteen points in a school year become Emerald School and the highest award for twenty points is the Evergreen Award.

4. Who should fill out our school's application?

The school coordinator should do this. Pictures are always good to include. We may post on the website.

5 . Who signs our application?

Your principal should sign and date your application.
