

No Health Insurance ? or On County Health Plan B?

Adult Medical Program (Plan A) Open Enrollment begins October 1, 2010 and ends November 30, 2010*

Apply at the Department of Human Services starting October 1, 2010*

Who Qualifies?

- Adults, age 18-64
- No minor children at home
- No income or low income:
 - \$316 a month if single person, \$425 a month for a married couple
 - (higher income if working)
- U.S. citizen, or legal resident for 5 years

Why Apply for Adult Medical Program (Plan A)?


- > Pays for basic medical care > Low or no co-pays
- > More coverage than County Health Plan B

How to Apply

- Use DHS Application Form (available at DHS office or online at Michigan.gov/dhs click on "Doing Business with DHS")
- Sign and Date Application
- Mail or Drop off Completed Application
- DHS will need proof of any income (past 30 days), bank or retirement accounts and investments, and where you live

* If you applied for medical assistance or Medicaid before October 1, 2010, file a NEW application or update your pending application. Contact your caseworker immediately.
