We have good news that we welcome you to share with your family and friends! Mid Michigan Community Action Agency (MMCAA) has received supplemental funding to reimburse clients for deliverable fuels purchased between January 1, 2014 and March 31, 2014. Those households who earned a gross income that falls between the income guidelines below can apply with MMCAA for reimbursement of up to \$850.

The following documentation is necessary to complete an application. **If you do not bring ALL of the documentation listed below to your appointment, the appointment will have to be rescheduled.**

1. Proof of all household income for all household members: including wages, Social Security, SSI, Pensions, child support, unemployment benefits, cash grant from DHS, etc. **(all monies coming into the home)** Bank statements are not proof of income: original award letters are required for Social Security, SSI etc.
2. Social Security cards for all household members.
3. Michigan Drivers License or Michigan I.D. with **current address** of applicant. *This address must match the address of service for utilities or delivery address for deliverable fuel.*
4. Proof of county of residence: Voter Registration, current Vehicle Registration or current Property Tax Statement. (effective July 1, 2011)
5. Receipt of deliverable fuel purchase dated between January 1, 2014 and March 31, 2014.

Call for an appointment at 989-386-3805, extension 1002. You may have to leave a message; you will receive a return call to schedule an appointment. There is no need to leave more than one message; your call will be returned within 2 working days. Due to the high demand for assistance, **walk-ins are not accepted.**
