 The injections will ONLY be given to those who cannot take the flu mist nasal spray

- * Anyone 65 or older will NOT be vaccinated unless they are a direct caregiver of a child six months of age or younger.
- * All minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Legal guardians must provide proof of guardianship.
- * Persons seeking the vaccine will need to bring photo identification and insurance card, if they have insurance. The vaccine is free, however, those persons with coverage may have their insurance billed a fee for administration of the vaccine. Those without insurance will not be charged the administration fee.
