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RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY, AND PARENTAL CONSENT AGREEMENT

In Consideration of being permitted to participate in any way in _____ I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heir, and next of kin:

1. Acknowledge, agree, and represent that I understand the nature of such activities and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activity. I further agree and warrant that if at any time I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the activity.

2. I fully understand that: (a) the activity undertaken involves risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death ("risk"); (b) these risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the action or inactions of others participating in the activity, the condition in which the activity take place, or the negligence of the Releases' named below; (c) there may be other risks and social economic loses either not know to me or not readily foreseeable at the time and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I incur as a result of my participation in the activity.

3. I hereby release, discharge, covenant not to sue, its respective, administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, (the Releases' hereon) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releases' or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations, and I further agree that if, despite the release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk and indemnity agreement, I or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against the Releases' I will defend indemnify, save and hold harmless each of the Releases' from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damages, or cost which may incur as a result of such claim.

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1. 2012 camp sites will be assigned by a Fair Board Camping Committee. Campers may camp in designated camping areas only. Anyone using more space than assigned will be asked to reduce the amount of space they are using, or will be asked to leave the camping area. Late entries will be assigned only if space is available.
2. All members camping are required to have an adult camping at the assigned site who will assume responsibility for the member's conduct. **The adult must spend the entire night at the site.** The names of these adults and all names of the campers must be listed on the 2012 Camping Application. All campers and guests that stay at the campsite must be **reported** to the campgrounds superintendent or they will be asked to leave.
3. No vehicle traffic will be permitted in camping areas or down the Midway area from Tuesday, August 7 through Saturday, August 11, 2012 between 12:00pm (noon) and 10:00pm.
4. No bikes, four-wheelers, golf carts or motorized vehicles are permitted on the fairgrounds unless preauthorized by the Bay County Fair Board at least one week prior to fair. This may be in writing or in person.
5. No horse is allowed in camping areas or on the rail trail at any time.
6. Pets must be on a short leash (less than 8 feet long) or in a crate. Owners will be asked to remove aggressive, vicious, obnoxious, or barking dogs from the fairgrounds. Pets such as dogs, cats, and pocket pets must be on a short leash or properly contained. Must be licensed, and all shots up to date.
7. No livestock animals may be housed at campers at any time.
8. Alcohol and drugs are not allowed on the Fairgrounds at any time.
9. No ground fires.
10. Camping areas must be clean at all times. Trash pick-up is the responsibility of the campers, please use appropriate containers.
11. Picnic tables are not provided for campers. You may bring your own.
12. Quiet hours are from 11:00pm to 6:00am. Everyone must be at their sites by 12:00pm.
13. Campers may set up their sites on Saturday, August 4, or Sunday, August 5, 2012 and may not leave before Sunday, August 12, 2012. You must have permission from Fair Board to leave early; area must be clean when pulling out.
14. All campers are to abide by these camping rules. Persons not following these guidelines may be asked to leave the camping area with no refund.
