

## Bay County Fair and Youth Exposition 2008 Camping Rules



1. The fee for camping is \$40.00 per site. The camping application form must be completed and submitted with the camping fee to MSU Extension - Bay County, 515 Center Ave., Bay City, MI 48708, by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 11, 2008. This money is due when the camping application is submitted and is non-refundable. **Make checks payable to MSU Extension.** MSU Extension - Bay County is collecting the camping fee on behalf of the Bay County Fair Board. *Two weekly parking passes are included in the camping fee.*
2. Camp sites will be assigned by the Campground Superintendent. Campers may camp in designated camping areas only. Anyone using more space than assigned will be asked to reduce the amount of space they are using, or will be asked to leave the camping area. Late entries will be assigned only if space is available.
3. All members camping are required to have an adult camping at the assigned site who will assume responsibility for the member's conduct. The adult must spend the entire night at the site. The names of these adults and all names of the campers must be listed on the 2008 Camping Application. All campers and guests who stay at the campsite must be reported to the Campground Superintendent or they will be asked to leave.
4. No vehicle traffic will be permitted in camping areas or down the Midway area from Tuesday, August 5, through Saturday, August 9, 2008, between 12:00 p.m. (noon) and 10:00 p.m.
5. No bikes, four-wheelers, golf carts or motorized vehicles are permitted on the Fairgrounds unless pre-authorized by the Bay County Fair Board at least one week prior to Fair.
6. No horses are allowed in camping areas or on the rail trail at any time.
7. Pets must be on a short leash (less than 8 feet long) or in a crate. Owners will be asked to remove aggressive, vicious, obnoxious, or barking dogs from the Fairgrounds.
8. No livestock animals may be housed at campers at any time. Pets such as dogs, cats, and pocket pets must be on a short leash or properly contained.
9. Alcohol and drugs are not allowed on the Fairgrounds at any time.
10. No ground fires.
11. Camping areas must be clean at all times. Trash pick-up is the responsibility of the camper.
12. Picnic tables are not provided for campers.
13. Quiet hours are from 12:30 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.
14. Camping applications *will not* be accepted at Fair Entry Registration.
15. Campers may set up their sites on Saturday, August 2, or Sunday, August 3, 2008, and may not leave before Sunday, August 10, 2008, at 10:00 a.m.
16. All campers are to abide by these camping rules. Persons not following these guidelines may be asked to leave the camping area with no refund.
