



A \$2.50 exhibitor's pass will be available daily, which will allow you access into the gate only.

OPEN HORSE REGULATIONS

- 1. Stallions must be handled by adults age 18 and older at all times.
- 2. Age of horse is as of January 1st. Age of rider is as of day of show.
- 3. Judge/Official will have the authority to disqualify as needed.
- 4. Color Breeds for Halter Classes must be able to prove registry, if requested, or they will be excused from the class with no refund.
- 5. Classes will be judged according to Michigan 4-H standards as outlined in the "4-H Horse and Pony Project Show Rules and Regulations."
- 6. Exhibitors must have their horses under control at all times. If any horse is present that endangers other horses or people; in the opinion of the superintendent, representative, judge or ringmaster; it may be excused from the ring and/or fairgrounds, whichever is deemed necessary. Those engaging in physical abuse or conduct including verbal abuse which threatens or endangers the health, safety, and/or well-being of any person or animal; will be asked to leave and will forfeit all premiums and awards.
- 7. A negative Coggins test will be required for all horses/ponies at the time of entry, as per current MDA legislation.
