

4. Color Breeds for Halter Classes must be able to prove registry, if requested, or they will be excused from the class with no refund.
5. Classes will be judged according to Michigan 4-H standards as outlined in the "4-H Horse and Pony Project Show Rules and Regulations."
6. Exhibitors must have their horses under control at all times. If any horse is present that endangers other horses or people; in the opinion of the superintendent, representative, judge or ringmaster; it may be excused from the ring and/or fairgrounds, whichever is deemed necessary. Those engaging in physical abuse or conduct including verbal abuse which threatens or endangers the health, safety, and/or well-being of any person or animal: will be asked to leave and will forfeit all premiums and awards.
7. A negative Coggins test will be required for all horses/ponies at the time of entry, as per current MDA legislation.
