Minimum Weights:

Steer- 1,000 pounds

Swine- 200 pounds

Lambs- 90 pounds

Goats- 50 pounds

Turkey- 15 pounds

Ducks- 5 pounds*

Geese- 8 pounds*

Chickens- 5 pounds*

Rabbits- 4 pounds*

* These weights also pertain to pens of multiples.

Butcher, cut, vacuum packed, and freeze - \$70.00
