Beef - Members have steer/heifer in possession by February 1, 2010, and photo of their animal with ear tag clearly represented turned in by February 15, 2010. Don't forget that steers/heifers must be born on or after January 1 of prior calendar year.

Swine - Members have possession of swine by May 1, 2010, and photo of their animal with ear tag clearly represented turned in by May 15, 2010. Don't forget that swine must be born on or after January 1, 2010.

Lambs - Members have lamb in possession by May 1, 2010, and photo of their animal with ear tag clearly represented turned in by May 15, 2010. Don't forget that lambs must be born on or after January 1, 2010.

Goats - Members have goats in possession by May 1, 2010, and photo of their animal with ear tag clearly represented turned in by May 15, 2010. Don't forget that goats must be born on or after January 1, 2010.

Waterfowl/Poultry - Members have waterfowl/ poultry in possession by June 15, 2010. Don't forget that waterfowl/ poultry must be born on or after January 1, 2010.

Rabbits - Members have rabbits in possession by June 15, 2010. Don't forget that rabbits must be born on or after January 1, 2010.

- Order steamed, grilled, or broiled dishes instead of those that are fried or sautéed.
- Resign from the “clean your plate club” – when you’ve eaten enough, leave the rest.




