**Into The Woods**


stars ~ Anna Kendrick, Meryl Streep

"Into the Woods" is a modern twist on the beloved Brothers Grimm fairy tales in a musical format that follows the classic tales of Cinderella, Little Red Riding Hood, Jack and the beanstalk, and Rapunzel—all tied together by an original story involving a baker and his wife, their wishes to begin a family and their interaction with the witch who has put a curse on them.

Meryl Streep was nominated for an Academy Award for her performance as the witch.

Rated PG for thematic elements, fantasy action and peril, and some suggestive material.

"Black and White" is the story of a grandfather who is suddenly left to care for his beloved granddaughter. When her paternal grandmother seeks custody with the help of her bother, the little girl is torn between two families who love her deeply. With the best intentions at heart, both families fight for what they feel is right & are soon forced to confront their true feelings about race, forgiveness, & understanding. The all-star cast brings superb acting to this movie. Based on real events, the movie is a look at two seemingly different worlds, in which nothing is as simple as black and white.
