


What would the Senior Millage increase pay for?

- Avoid placing clients on a waiting list.
- Help meet the current and future growing demand for services.
- Kitchen renovations and equipment replacement
- Prevent any interruption of senior service.

A .30 Senior Millage renewal equates to how much?

A proposed .30 mills increase equates to \$15 annually for the owner of a home valued at \$100,000 (taxable value approximately \$50,000).



How many senior citizens are there in Bay County and what percent receive services from the Division on Aging?

There are approximately 24,409 senior citizens (age 60+) in Bay County. It is estimated that 12% of the county's residents receives Division on Aging services, and 41% are below poverty level.
