



Bay City Mayor's Annual Clean-Up Day

Mayor Charlie Brunner's Annual Cleanup Day is taking place Saturday, April 17, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. This annual event provides residents with the perfect opportunity to get rid of all their unwanted items **FREE**. Do not miss this opportunity . . . it only happens once a year!

Dumpster Locations

The following are the four dumpster locations in the city receiving materials:

- ✧ Fisher Street Parking Lot (612 E. Fisher Street)
- ✧ Cass Avenue Boat Launch (620 Harrison Street)
- ✧ Defoe Park (601 Marquette Avenue)
- ✧ Maplewood Park (Third Street & Sherman)

Acceptable Items:

Acceptable materials include furniture, mattresses/box springs, carpets, toys, bicycles, barbeque grills, and pipe not exceeding 3' in length.

Items That Cannot Be Accepted:

Items that cannot be accepted include appliances (white goods), batteries, barrels or drums, bricks, bullets or shells, car parts, combustible materials, commercial or contractor waste, concrete, dirt, food waste, gas cylinders, liquid and hazardous waste, paint cans, rocks, steel pipe, toxic materials, tree stumps, yard waste, or tires.

Special Note - Appliances:

Residents may take all appliances to Stambaugh Appliance, 408 Columbus Avenue, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. for proper disposal at no charge.

Residential Recycling Containers:

In an effort to further increase residential recycling, the City will provide recycling containers to city residents at each dumpster location. One container per household.

To take part in this day, individuals must be a City of Bay City resident. A copy of a recent Bay City utility bill and photo identification will be required at the event as proof of residency and to obtain "free" disposal.

The Mayor's Annual Clean-up Day will take place rain or shine.
