Team Entry Fees are \$275 for U8 & U10 and \$300 for U12 & U14 – 6 games guarantee!

Age Divisions

Teams can have 1 goalie and up to 6 skaters on the roster. Each team must have at least 3 skaters to participate. Each game is 30 minutes in length. USA Hockey rules are in effect except where amended below:

3 on 3 Cross Ice Rules and Regulations

- Games will have two halves that are 12 minutes long with running clock. 2 minute warm up and 1 minute intermission between halves.
- There will be no timeouts (even during Championship games) and an 8 goal game cap.
- Regular scheduled games can end in a tie. Playoff games must have a winner. If a playoff game ends in a tie, teams will play a 6 minute running clock sudden death overtime. If the game is still tied then a sudden death shootout will take place. 1 round until a winner is decided.
- All players must wear full gear. Neck guards are required and any player who doesn't abide by this rule will NOT be allowed to compete.
- Teams can consist of up to 7 players: 6 skaters and one goalie with a minimum of at least 4 skaters.
- NO CHECKING-NO SLAP SHOTS.
- There will be one official per game.
- Penalties will result in a penalty shot. Fighting will NOT be tolerated. All fights will result in automatic tournament ejection for the WHOLE team. (NO REFUND)
- Games will be played cross ice within the blue lines. The Neutral zone will be used for tournament officials only. After a goal, all players are required to check up before they can attack the opposing team. The team that is scored on is expected to pull the puck out and start playing while the other team checks up.
- Players are allowing to change on the fly.
- Players must have USA Hockey and Canadian proof of insurance available upon request.
- Age certification required by providing a copy of birth certificate on-site during tournament dates. Team managers can be asked for proof of Date of Birth by Bay County Civic Arena staff. Failure to provide proof may result in disqualification from tournament games.

PENALTIES---ALL USA Hockey & M.A.H.A. RULES APPLY

- Referee game decisions are absolute and final.
- Verbal and or Physical abuse of referees, fans, teams, staff, or Tournament officials will result in immediate suspension from Tournament play for an indefinite period of time. Further action may be taken by M.A.H.A. if deemed necessary.
