WHER	į	In an effort to offer consistency and equity, all Bay County buildings will observe Juneteenth by closing operations as it would other federally recognized holidays; and
WHER	**************************************	The Personnel Director will engage in reaching out to the 13 bargaining units to reach a letter of understanding to add this to the current collective bargaining agreements; and
WHER		The additional cost to the County, due to 24/7 facility operations, is estimated at \$50,000 annually; Therefore, Be It
RESOL		That the Bay County Board of Commissioners approves amendment to the current collective bargaining agreements to add Juneteenth as a Federal Holiday; Be It Further
