<p><u>Phase 1A:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paid and unpaid persons serving in health care settings who have the potential for direct or indirect exposure to patients or infectious materials and are unable to work from home • Residents of long-term care facilities 	<p>Yes!</p>	<p>Follow instructions from your employer or wait to hear from BCHD.</p> <p>We will contact those who aren't being vaccinated through a hospital or health system.</p> <p>If you are a 1A provider not being vaccinated by your employer, please complete this survey if you haven't already: www.surveymonkey.com/r/bchd-c19vx</p>
<p><u>Phase 1B:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People 65 years of age or older • Frontline essential workers in critical infrastructure 	<p>Yes!</p>	<p>Fill out BCHD registration survey and/or contact your health care provider.</p> <p>If you are a frontline essential worker in critical infrastructure or over 65, please complete this survey to help us prepare for vaccine distribution: www.surveymonkey.com/r/bchd-c19vx and wait to hear from the BCHD.</p> <p>Note: The survey is the preferred method to register, however, a COVID-19 Vaccine registration hotline has been established for individuals who do not have internet access. They may call 989-308-1828 to complete the registration for the vaccine.</p>
<p><u>Phase 1C:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People 16 years of age or older at high risk of severe illness due to COVID-19 infection • Some other essential workers whose position impacts life, safety, and protection during the COVID-19 response 	<p>Not yet.</p>	<p>Continue to wait for guidance from BCHD and/or your health care provider.</p>
