

COVID-19 Guidelines/Procedures

If you have a fever or are experiencing any other symptoms of COVID-19, you may not enter the facility. Thank you.



Masks:

- Masks are required at all times inside the facility, including while on the ice, locker rooms, restrooms and common areas.

Staff:

- Staff members will have their temperature taken before the start of each shift.
- Masks will be required.

Cleaning:

- Additional cleaning procedures have been implemented. We will be sanitizing high traffic areas on a regular basis.
- Please do your part and wash your hands regularly and pick up after yourselves.

Capacity Restrictions:

- Only two spectators will be allowed to accompany a participant at any time in the arena with the exception of adult league. They will have no spectators.

Locker rooms:

- Users should come to the rink assuming that a locker room will not be available.
- Available locker rooms will be marked for social distancing. Locker rooms will hold 7-8 participants, depending on the room.
- Participants are encouraged to shower at home.

Social Distancing:

- All guests are expected to adhere to 6 foot social distancing guidelines at all times where practicable.
- Sneeze guards have been placed at the front desk. The Pro Shop and skate rental are closed.
- Social distancing markers have been placed on the floor at all the locations listed above.
- Spectator stands have been marked for social distancing.
- Main entry doors have been marked with the north side "Ice Activities Entrance Only" and "Ice Activities Exit Only" South entrance is for Immunization Clinic use only at this time.
- Lobby tables and chairs are to be used by members of the same household only.

Miscellaneous:

- Please arrive only 15 minutes before your scheduled ice time period and depart within 20 minutes.
- Water fountains will not be available, but water bottle sinks will be available at your own risk.
- Concessions will not be available at this time.

Coaches & Teams / Participants:

- Each coach is responsible for the actions of its team/participants and the spectators of its team/participant members. Violations of these guidelines/procedures may lead to team/participant suspension.
- Coaches and players are expected to follow MAHA's Return to Play Guidelines as well as the guidelines set forth in Governor Whitmer's Executive Orders.
