CANVASS OF ELECTION
OCTOBER 17, 2001**

THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS MET ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2001, IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM ON THE FOURTH FLOOR OF THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING. THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WAS TO CANVASS THE VOTES CAST DURING THE BANGOR TOWNSHIP MILLAGE ELECTION (PUBLIC SAFETY/LOCAL ROAD ISSUES) HELD ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2001. THE FOLLOWING OBSERVATIONS WERE MADE BY THE BOARD MEMBERS DURING THE CANVASS OF VOTES. THE MEMBERS PRESENT WERE:

CANVASS OF THE VOTES COMMENCED:

PRECINCT 3

THE POLL BOOK INDICATED THE NUMBER OF VOTERS WAS 185; THE STATEMENT OF VOTES SHOWED 184 AND 183.

PRECINCT 5

THE LIST OF VOTERS IN THE POLL BOOK INDICATED 238 LESS 5 SPOILED BALLOTS. THE TALLY SHEET AND THE STATEMENT OF VOTES LISTED 232. THE INSTRUCTIONS ON THE STATEMENT OF VOTES SPECIFIES THAT THE NUMBER OF VOTES SHOULD BE WRITTEN, NOT PRINTED.

AV

ON THE STATEMENT OF VOTES, THE NUMBER OF BALLOTS CAST WAS NOT SHOWN ON THE COVER. CONFIRMED, FOLLOWING CONVERSATION WITH JANET SANTOS, BANGOR TOWNSHIP CLERK. THE AV LIST TOTAL SHOWED 625 BALLOTS WERE RETURNED PRIOR TO THE DATE OF ELECTION . ELEVEN BALLOTS WERE RETURNED ON ELECTION DAY, BUT NOT ADDED TO THE 625 INDICATED ON THE AV LIST. THE NEW TOTAL SHOULD BE 636 (625 + 11) LESS ONE SPOILED BALLOT (635). THE FIGURE "635" IS ONE MORE THAN THE TOTALS ON THE TALLY SHEET (634).
