

**BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS
GENERAL ELECTION
NOVEMBER 6, 2012**

THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS CONVENED ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2012 IN THE GROUND FLOOR CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING TO CANVASS THE DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED BY LOCAL JURISDICTIONS IN THE TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2012 GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE COUNTY OF BAY. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 1:00 P.M. WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT:

THE FOLLOWING NOTATIONS REPRESENT THE FINDINGS OF THE BOARD AS LISTED BY EACH INDIVIDUAL PRECINCT.

CITY OF AUBURN- THE PROPOSAL LANGUAGE HAD NOT BEEN INCLUDED IN THE POLL BOOK. ONLY ONE (1) TOTAL TAPE WAS SUBMITTED. MISSING WAS THE SIGNATURE OF THE WITNESS WHO OBSERVE THE SEALING OF THE BALLOT CONTAINER. WORKERS HAD NOT TALLIED A TOTAL OF THE WRITE-IN VOTES CAST FOR EACH CANDIDATE WHERE NECESSARY.

BANGOR TWP, PRECINCT 1- NO PROBLEMS TO REPORT IN THIS PRECINCT.

BANGOR TWP., PRECINCT 2- NO PROBLEMS TO REPORT IN THIS PRECINCT

BANGOR TWP., PRECINCT 3- THE STATEMENT OF VOTES AND TALLY LIST A TOTAL OF 954 VOTES WHILE THE POLL BOOK DOCUMENTATION DID NOT MATCH. THE PRECINCT CHAIRPERSON WAS CALLED TO EXPLAIN AND DID JUSTIFY THE DISCREPANCIES IN THE FIGURES.

BANGOR TWP. PRECINCT 4- THE STATEMENT OF VOTES SHEET HAD NOT CONTAINED THE SIGNATURE OF THE PERSON WHO WITNESSED SEALING.

BANGOR TWP. PRECINCT 5- NO ISSUES TO REPORT IN THIS PRECINCT.

BANGOR TWP, PRECINCT 6- THE STATEMENT OF VOTES SHEET DID NOT INCLUDE THE SEAL NUMBER FOR THE TABULATOR AT THE CLOSE OF THE POLLS.

BANGOR A.V. 1- THE LIST OF A.V. VOTERS WAS NOT INCLUDED IN THE MATERIALS SUBMITTED TO THE CANVASS BOARD, THE CLERK WAS CONTACTED AND THE CANVASS PROCEEDED ONCE PROVIDED.

BANGOR A.V.2- THE COUNT OF VOTES DID NOT MATCH THE STATEMENT OF VOTES TALLY. NOTES INDICATED THAT ONE (1) BALLOT HAD BEEN RUN IN THE TABULATOR TWICE DURING SOME JAMMING. WHEN THE CHAIR WAS CALLED TO EXPLAIN, WAS UNABLE TO IDENTIFY WHY AN ADDITIONAL BALLOT WAS RECORDED BUT BELIEVE IT WAS DUE TO THE JAM EXPERIENCED BY THE MACHINE.

BAY CITY, WARD 1, PRECINCT 1- THE WRITE-IN STATEMENT OF VOTES DID NOT TALLY FOR EACH CANDIDATE THAT HAD RECEIVED VOTES.

BAY CITY, WARD 1, PRECINCT 2- THE STATEMENT OF VOTES/TALLY TAPE INDICATES 1312 VOTERS. POLL BOOK LIST OF VOTERS INDICATE 1314. THE FIGURES DID NOT AGREE AND WITH NOTHING DOCUMENTED IN THE POLL BOOK REMARKS SECTION, THE CHAIRPERSON WAS CALLED TO COME TO THE COUNTY BUILDING AND RECTIFY THE ISSUES FOR THE CANVASS BOARD.

THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS RECESSED ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2012 AT 5:00 P.M. AND AFFIXED SEAL NUMBER 699691 TO THE BALLOT CAN.

THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS RECONVENED ON THURSDAY, **NOVEMBER 8, 2012** AT 9:00 A.M. IN THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT ON THIS DATE:

THE CANVASS PROCESS CONTINUED FOLLOWING THE OPENING OF THE BALLOT CONTAINER ONCE THE SEAL NUMBER WAS VERIFIED.

BAY CITY, WARD 3, PRECINCT 1- ONLY ONE (1) TALLY TAPE HAD BEEN PROVIDED FOR THE CANVASS BOARD REVIEW. THE TOTAL OF WRITE-IN VOTES CAST FOR CANDIDATES ON THE STATEMENT OF VOTES HAD NOT BEEN COMPLETED. ON THE CERTIFICATE OF ELECTION INSPECTOR, THERE WERE NO SIGNATURES OF THE WITNESSES WHO VERIFIED THE SEALING OF THE CONTAINER AND CONFIRMATION OF SEAL NUMBER.

BAY CITY, WARD 4, PRECINCT 1- THERE WAS ONLY ONE (1) TALLY TAPE FOR BOARD OF CANVASSER REVIEW. THE SIGNATURE OF THE PERSON WHO ADMINISTERED THE OATH TO THE ELECTION INSPECTORS HAD NOT BEEN DOCUMENTED ON THE POLL BOOK. THE POLL BOOK LIST OF VOTERS INDICATED 1153 VOTERS WHICH DID NOT MATCH THE OTHER FIGURES. A TOTAL NUMBER OF VOTES CAST FOR WRITE-IN CANDIDATES HAD NOT BEEN TALLIED BY THE WORKERS. A SIGNATURE WAS MISSING ON THE TALLY TAPE AND THE PHONE NUMBERS OF THE WORKERS HAD

NOT BEEN LISTED IN THE SPACES PROVIDED. THE CHAIRPERSON WAS CALLED AND JUSTIFIED A DISCREPANCY AS A PROVISIONAL BALLOT. THIS MAY HAVE CAUSED A DIFFERENCE IN THE BALLOT NUMBER CALCULATIONS BUT WAS THEN RESOLVED BY THE WORKERS AT THE POLLS. THERE WERE NO REMARKS IN THE POLL BOOK TO EXPLAIN THE EVENTS OF THE PROVISIONAL BALLOT AND/OR THE FIGURES WHICH DID NOT MATCH.

BAY CITY WARD 5, PRECINCT 1- THERE WAS NO SIGNATURE FOR THE PERSON ADMINISTERING THE OATH TO THE ELECTION INSPECTORS AND AFTER BEING CALLED BY THE BOARD MEMBERS, APPEARED AT THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING ON 11/14/12 TO COMPLETE. THE CHAIRPERSON HAD SIGNED BOTH LINES FOR ADMINISTERING THE OATH TO THE CHAIR, BUT NEEDED A SEPARATE INDIVIDUAL TO SWEAR IN THE CHAIRPERSON. THE CANVASSER ENVELOPE ONLY CONTAINED ONE (1) TOTAL TAPE AND THE STATEMENT OF VOTES CAST SHEET HAD NOT TOTALED THE VOTES CAST FOR THE WRITE IN CANDIDATES.

BAY CITY WARD 6, PRECINCT 1- THE STATEMENT OF VOTES SHEET HAD NOT INCLUDED TOTALS FOR THE WRITE-IN CANDIDATES AND FURTHER, BRANDON DEFRAIN WAS LISTED INCORRECTLY AS A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE FOR THE OFFICE OF COUNTY SHERIFF.

BAY CITY WARD 7, PRECINCT 1- MISSING WAS A SIGNATURE OF A PERSON WHO SWORE IN THE ELECTION INSPECTORS, ONCE CALLED, APPEARED AT THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING ON 11/15/12 TO COMPLETE THIS. THERE WERE NO REMARKS INCLUDED IN THE POLL BOOK.

BAY CITY WARD 8, PRECINCT 1- ONLY ONE (1) TOTAL TAPE WAS INCLUDED THE STATEMENT OF VOTES SHEET DID NOT HAVE THE TOTALS COMPILED FOR EACH OF THE WRITE-IN CANDIDATES. THE POLL BOOK TOTAL SHOWN TOTAL VOTES OF 1185 WHILE THE TOTAL TAPE DENOTES 1184. THE POLL BOOK REMARKS SECTION DID NOT INCLUDE AND EXPLANATION SO THE CHAIRPERSON WAS CALLED WHO RECTIFIED THE FIGURES PRESENTED.

BAY CITY WARD 9, PRECINCT 1- ONLY ONE (1) TALLY TAPE PROVIDED. ON THE STATEMENT OF VOTES SHEET, THE WRITE-IN TOTALS PER CANDIDATE WERE NOT INDIVIDUALLY TALLIED. ONE VOTER SPOILED A BALLOT AND THE BALLOT NUMBER REISSUED WAS NOT PROPERLY NOTED IN THE POLL BOOK. NO REMARKS IN THE PROPER SECTION TO EXPLAIN. THE TOTAL VOTES CAST ON THE BALLOT SUMMARY SHEET REFLECTED A NEGATIVE 182 VOTES AND WITH NO EXPLANATION, THE CITY CLERK WAS NOTIFIED TO SUMMON THE PRECINCT CHAIRPERSON TO RECALCULATE. WHEN THE CHAIR CONTACTED THE CANVASS BOARD. IT WAS DETERMINED A ERROR HAD OCCURRED WHEN ENTERING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF BALLOTS THE PRECINCT STARTED WITH WHICH CAUSED THE MINUS IN TOTAL VOTES CALCULATED.

THE BOARD TOOK A BREAK FOR LUNCH AT 11:50 A.M. AND AFFIXED SEAL 699679 TO THE CONTAINER CONTAINING THE CANVASS MATERIALS. THE BOARD RECONVENED AT 1:13 P.M. WITH THE BALLOT SEAL VERIFIED.

BAY CITY, A.V. 1- THERE WERE NO PROBLEMS TO REPORT WITH THE DOCUMENTATION PRESENTED.

BAY CITY, A.V. 2 - THERE WERE NO PROBLEMS TO REPORT WITH THE DOCUMENTATION PRESENTED.

FRANKENLUST TOWNSHIP- THERE WERE NO SIGNATURES OF WORKERS WHO WITNESSED THE SEALING OF THE BALLOT CAN AT THE DAY END. THE POLL BOOK INDICATED 1429 VOTES CAST WHILE THE TALLY SHEET SHOWN A FIGURE OF 1428 VOTES. THE CHAIRPERSON WAS CALLED TO EXPLAIN THE DIFFERENCE.

FRANKENLUST A.V.- NO PROBLEMS TO REPORT WITH DOCUMENTATION.

GIBSON TOWNSHIP- THE LIST OF VOTERS PRESENTED WERE OUT OF THE NORMAL NUMBER ORDER. BALLOT SUMMARY SHEET CALCULATED A TOTAL OF 545 VOTERS BUT POLL BOOK INDICATED 539 VOTERS. THE CHAIRPERSON WAS CALLED TO JUSTIFY BUT WITH UNCERTAINTY OF THE REASONS, THE CANVASS BOARD VOTED BY 4 YEAS AND 0 NAYS, TO RERUN THE TOTAL NUMBER OF BALLOTS CAST IN THIS PRECINCT. TOWNSHIP CLERK AND PRECINCT CHAIRPERSON WERE CONTACTED TO PRODUCE ALL DOCUMENTS AND APPEAR IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2012 DO PERFORM THIS TASK WITH CANVASS BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT. A REASON THIS WAS REQUESTED WAS DUE TO THE FACT THAT THE PRECINCT HAD A NUMBER OF PROBLEMS WITH BALLOTS "JAMMING" AND ALTERING THE ACTUAL COUNT OF VOTES CASTING BALLOTS. ADDITIONALLY, ONE (1) BALLOT HAD BEEN DUPLICATED TWO TIMES AS THE ELECTION INSPECTOR HAD MADE AN ERROR DURING THE DUPLICATION PROCESS. THIS PARTICULAR TOWNSHIP ALSO RECORDED TWO (2) PROVISIONAL BALLOTS WHICH WERE DEEMED UNCOUNTABLE BY THE COUNTY AND TOWNSHIP CLERK DURING THE CANVASS. THE BALLOT OF A. STANLEY WAS NOT INCLUDED AS MS. STANLEY HAD JUST REGISTERED TO VOTE IN GIBSON TOWNSHIP ON 10/16/2012, THE CLOSE OF THE REGISTRATION PERIOD WAS 10/9/2012. SECONDLY, THE BALLOT OF M. SWEET WAS NOT COUNTED AS MS. SWEET WAS GIVEN AMPLE OPPORTUNITY TO SUBMIT PROOF OF HER RESIDENCY AT THE HOME HER PARENTS OWN, BUT DID NOT DO SO IN ORDER TO SUBSTANTIATE HER RESIDENCY IN GIBSON TOWNSHIP. DURING THE TABULATION OF BALLOTS AT THE CLERK OFFICE, IT WAS NOTED THAT OVER 100 BALLOTS CONTAINED THE NUMBERED STUB AT THE BOTTOM. 100 BALLOTS WITH STUBS.

CITY OF PINCONNING- NO PROBLEMS TO REPORT WITH DOCUMENTATION FROM THE CITY OF PINCONNING.




