CANVASS OF THE NOVEMBER 8, 1988 GENERAL ELECTION

THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS MET AT THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING ON NOVEMBER 9TH, 1988, AT 1:00 P.M., TO ORGANIZE FOR THE CANVASS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS. THE BOARD AGREED TO MEET ON NOVEMBER 10TH, AND 14TH, AND THUS CONCLUDED THE REVIEW OF DOCUMENTS ON NOVEMBER 22, 1988. 6-3 MACHINE NUMBER 111502, 11/10/88, WHEN CLOSING READ 18554, WHEN OPENED 18352, THE TOTAL NUMBER OF VOTES CAST THEREFORE SHOULD BE 202, RETURN SHEET STATED 201.

5-3 MACHINE NUMBER 73267, WHEN CLOSED READ 23257, WHEN OPENED READ 23020, TOTAL VOTES CAST THEREFORE SHOULD BE 237 WHILE THE RETURN SHEET READ 236.

MERRITT TOWNSHIP

DID NOT SHOW THE NUMBER OF VOTES SHOWN ON THE PUBLIC COUNTER OF MACHINE NUMBER 74779. THE FIGURE (132) SHOULD HAVE BEEN RECORDED.

GIBSON TOWNSHIP

ABSENT VOTER TOTAL FOR PROPOSAL B ON THE RETURN SHEET READ 40 VOTES. THE TOTAL ABSENT VOTER TOTAL ACCORDING TO THE POLL BOOK WAS 39.

HAMPTON TOWNSHIP

IN PRECINCT NUMBER TWO, THE PROTECTIVE COUNTER TOTALS WERE TRANSPOSED.

IN PRECINCT NUMBER FOUR, THE SEAL NUMBER APPEARED IN THE SPACE PROVIDED FOR THE FIGURES OF THE PROTECTIVE COUNTER ON MACHINE NO. 75550.

CERTIFICATE NO. 1 - CONFIRMED NUMBER OF COUNTER WITH THE HAMPTON TOWNSHIP CLERK FROM THE ENVELOPE WHICH READ 019048.

BANGOR TOWNSHIP

UPON TALLY OF THE BANGOR A.V. BALLOTS, THE BOARD DISCOVERED THAT THE TOTAL NUMBER OF VOTES EXCEEDED THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PEOPLE WHO VOTED. THE BANGOR TWP. CLERK SHALL RECONVENE THE A.V. BOARD TO RECOUNT THE A.V. BALLOTS.

THE CLERK, SHARON RUSSELL, SHALL DO AN A.V. BALLOT RECOUNT. SHE HAD BEEN VERBALLY INSTRUCTED TO DO SO AND ALSO NOTIFIED BY LETTER. THE BOARD SHALL RECONVENE FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 1988 FOR THE PURPOSE OF A.V. BALLOT RECOUNT.

BANGOR TOWNSHIP - PRECINCT #3 - MACHINE 144566 SHOWED OPENING NUMBER AS 712178 WHICH WAS ACTUALLY THE SEAL NUMBER. THERE WERE NO OPENING NUMBERS RECORDED.

BANGOR TOWNSHIP - PRECINCT #5 - THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS WERE UNABLE TO READ THE NUMBERS RECORDED.

BANGOR TOWNSHIP - PRECINCT #6 - THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS WERE UNABLE TO READ THE NUMBERS RECORDED.

BANGOR TOWNSHIP - PRECINCT #7 - THE ELECTION WORKERS DID NOT ENTER THE BEGINNING PROTECTIVE COUNTER NUMBERS. THE COUNTY CLERKS OFFICE CONTACTED THE CLERK, SHARON RUSSELL, TO VERIFY THE CORRECT NUMBERS. THE FIGURES SHOULD HAVE READ 11635 INSTEAD OF 1635.

CITY OF AUBURN

THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS DISCOVERED TWO ERRORS IN ADDITION CALCULATIONS.

BAY CITY A.V.#7 - THIS HAD BEEN OPENED AND RESEALED FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING THE POLL BOOK, BY LINDA TOBER, DEPUTY COUNTY CLERK.

BAY CITY A.V. #9 - THIS HAD BEEN OPENED AND RESEALED FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING THE POLL BOOK, BY LINDA TOBER, DEPUTY COUNTY CLERK.


