PROPOSAL 14-1

A REFERENDUM OF PUBLIC ACT 520 OF 2012, ESTABLISHING A HUNTING SEASON FOR WOLVES AND AUTHORIZING ANNUAL WOLF HUNTING SEASONS

Public Act 520 of 2012 would:

- Designate wolf as game for hunting purposes and authorize the first wolf hunting season.
- Allow the Natural Resources Commission to schedule annual wolf hunting seasons.
- Provide criminal penalties for the unlawful possession or taking of wolves, but shield a person who lawfully captures or destroys a wolf from prosecution.
- Require a person who wishes to hunt wolves to obtain a wolf hunting license.
- Create a Wolf Management Advisory Council for the purpose of making nonbinding recommendations to the legislature regarding the proper management of wolves.

Should this law be approved?

PROPOSAL 14-2

A REFERENDUM OF PUBLIC ACT 21 OF 2013, GRANTING THE NATURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION THE POWER TO DESIGNATE WOLVES AND CERTAIN OTHER ANIMALS AS GAME WITHOUT LEGISLATIVE ACTION

Public Act 21 of 2013 would:

- Allow the Natural Resources Commission (NRC) to designate certain animals as game for hunting purposes and establish the first hunting season for game animals without legislative action.
- Continue the NRC's designation of wolves as game and allow the NRC to set a wolf hunting season.
- Grant the Legislature sole authority to remove a species from the list of designated game animals.
- Eliminate the \$1.00 hunting and fishing licensing fee for members of the military, whether stationed inside or outside of Michigan, subject to any lottery.
- Give the NRC sole authority to regulate fishing.

HISTORICAL PRESERVATION MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will permit Bay County to renew the previous levy of .1 mill for historical preservation services through the Bay County Historical Society or other entity.

Shall the expired previous voted increase on the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Bay County of .1 mills (10 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value), previously approved by the voters and reduced to .0952 mills (9.52 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at .0952 mills (9.52 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 20 years, December 2014 through December 2033 (inclusive), to be used to preserve Bay County's unique history, educate citizens, conduct projects, operate and maintain a museum, raising an estimated \$271,695.86 in the first year the millage is levied?

Shall the limitation of the amount of property taxes which may be levied each year against property in the County of Bay be increased by .75 of a mill (75 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value), previously approved by voters and reduced to .7476 mills (74.76 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, on the taxable valuation of real and personal property situated in the County of Bay for a period of five (5) years, 2016 through 2020, inclusive, the said millage to be used exclusively for the continued operation of the Bay Metropolitan Transportation Authority? (This is a renewal of the .75 of a mill previously approved by voters that expires in 2015). If approved and levied, the estimated revenue during the first year of the millage would be \$2,133,611.63.
