**Write-In Candidates who filed for write-in seats include:** Essexville City Council Member - Craig Goulet, Pinconning City Council Member - Christopher Heading, Renee Jasure and Becky A. Lesniak, Bay City Public School Board - Tom Baird and Brad Jeske. Declarations of Intent were filed by these candidates as of Friday, October 26, 2018 and posted with this notice to meet publication deadlines. The State Bureau of Election deadline for any write-in candidate is Friday, October 26, 2018 by 4:00 p.m. with the respective filing official.

**Proposals:**

The following is a summary of the three (3) State proposals, one (1) County proposal, one (1) local proposal and one (1) local school proposal which shall be considered on the November 6, 2018 ballot:

**State Proposal 18-1**

A proposed initiated law to authorize and legalize possession, use and cultivation of marijuana products by individuals who are at least 21 years of age and older, and commercial sales of marijuana through state-licensed retailers

**State Proposal 18-2**

A proposed constitutional amendment to establish a commission of citizens with exclusive authority to adopt district boundaries for the Michigan Senate, Michigan House of Representatives and U.S. Congress, every 10 years.

**State Proposal 18-3**

A proposal to authorize automatic and Election Day voter registration, no-reason absentee voting; and add current legal requirements for military and overseas voting and post-election audits to the Michigan Constitution.

**Bay Metropolitan Transportation Authority Millage (Countywide)**

The millage proposal is for an increase of 1 mill for a period of 5 years for the purpose of continued operation of the Bay Metropolitan Transportation Authority.

**Kawkawlin Township Road Millage (Local)**

Kawkawlin Township Proposal to renew voted millage for maintenance of local roads. Renewal of 1 mill for a period of 4 years, 12/1/2018 through 12/1/2021 inclusive for construction, maintenance and improvement of local public roads. Will raise \$140,000 in the first year of the levy.

**Essexville-Hampton School District (Local School)**

Essexville-Hampton Public Schools Sinking Fund Millage: Proposal to authorize a levy not to exceed 3 mills for a period of 10 years, 2020 to 2029, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate, construction/repair of school buildings, security improvements, technology and other purposes authorized by law. Will collect if the millage is approved \$947,187.
