

BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS

TUESDAY, MARCH 24, 1987

THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS MET ON TUESDAY, MARCH 24, 1987 AT 3:00 P.M. TO CANVASS THE VOTES FOR THE DELTA COLLEGE MILLAGE PROPOSAL HELD ON MARCH 23, 1987.

PRESENT WERE: BOARD OF CANVASSERS: HAROLD MCDUGALD, ROY FRECH, DON CHEVALIER, AND CHAIRMAN DONALD REETZ.

ALSO PRESENT: TALLY CLERKS: BEV SNABLE, BEA CODY

THE BOARD PROCEEDED TO CANVASS THE RESULTS OF THE ELECTION AND IT WAS BROUGHT TO THEIR ATTENTION BY THE CLERK THAT THE VOTES SHOWING FOR THE ABSENTEE COUNTING BOARD IN BANGOR TOWNSHIP WERE QUESTIONABLE DUE TO THE FACT THAT THE MILLAGE HAD BEEN DEFEATED THROUGHOUT THE MAJORITY OF THE PRECINCTS AND IT SHOWED THE MILLAGE PASSING BY A COUNT OF 312 TO 100.

THE COUNTY CLERK REQUESTED THE BANGOR TOWNSHIP CLERK TO BRING THE BALLOTS TO THE CLERKS OFFICE FOR THE CANVASSERS TO RECOUNT. THIS WAS DONE AT THE TIME OF THE CANVASS, SHOWING 100 YES VOTES AND 312 NO VOTES, SO BEING A TRANSPOSITION OF FIGURES AT THE CLOSE OF THE ELECTION NIGHT.

THE TOTAL VOTES FOR THE DELTA COLLEGE MILLAGE PROPOSAL WAS 11,128 SHOWING 3792 YES VOTES AND 7336 NO VOTES.

THE MILLAGE PROPOSAL IN BAY COUNTY WAS THEREFORE DECLARED DEFEATED.

THE BOARD ADJOURNED AT 4:15 PM.
