WITH THE DISCREPANCY OF TOTALS FOR THE AUGUST 4, 1986 PRIMARY ELECTION, THE COUNTY CLERK ORDERED THAT A TESTING OF MACHINE 75545 IN FRASER TOWNSHIP PRECINCT 2 WOULD BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 18, 1986 AT 2:00 P.M.

AT THE OPENING OF MACHINE 75545, THE SEAL # READ 258285 WHICH CHECKED WITH THE RETURN SHEETS. THE PUBLIC COUNTER READ 76 AND WAS CHECKED WITH THE RETURN SHEET. THE PROTECTIVE COUNTER READ 017909 AND CHECKED WITH THE RETURN SHEET.

THE VOTE ON THE MACHINE READ:



MR. BRADFORD PROCEEDED TO CLEAR THE MACHINE AND SET BACK THE FIGURES TO 000 FOR THE PROPOSITION. UPON CLEARING THE MACHINE ONE ZERO DID NOT GO BACK UP ALL THE WAY, THEREFORE, THE MACHINE WAS VOTED THREE TIMES TO MAKE SURE THE NUMBERS DID SHOW COMPLETELY, BRINGING THE PROTECTIVE COUNTER TO 017913 AT THE TIME OF STARTING THE TESTING.


MACHINE 75545 WAS VOTED 200 TIMES BY THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS. THE TOTAL VOTE SHOWED 100 YES AND 100 NO. THE PROTECTIVE COUNTER READ 018113 AND THE PUBLIC COUNTER READ 200.

THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS AGREED THAT THE MACHINE 75545 WAS WORKING PROPERLY AND FELT THERE WAS NOT A MALFUNCTION OF THE MACHINE. THEY ALSO AGREED THAT THE MACHINE WAS LEFT WITH NUMBERS ON THE COUNTER.

THE TESTING WAS CONCLUDED AT 3:45 P.M.




