JANICE PIERSON WAS UNANIMOUSLY NOMINATED VICE-CHAIRPERSON.

JANICE PIERSON WAS ELECTED VICE-CHAIRPERSON BY UNANIMOUS CONSENT.

THE MINUTES OF THE NOVEMBER 5, 2013 ELECTION CANVASS WAS APPROVED BY UNANIMOUS CONSENT.

THE CANVASS OF THE VOTES COMMENCED.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MICHIGAN ELECTION CONSOLIDATION LAW OF 2005, BANGOR TOWNSHIP CONDUCTS ITS OWN ELECTION DUE TO THE FACT THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT IS CONTAINED WITHIN ONE TOWNSHIP WITH THE BANGOR TOWNSHIP CLERK AS COORDINATOR. BANGOR TOWNSHIP SCHOOL ELECTION IS CANVASSED BY THE BAY COUNTY CANVASS BOARD.

11,986 REGISTERED VOTERS FOR THIS ELECTION. 1179 BALLOTS CAST.

ENVELOPES WERE SEALED.


THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS COMPLETED THE CANVASS OF THE
