

BAY COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION
PRIMARY BALLOT APPROVAL
JUNE 23, 1992

THE BAY COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION MET ON TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 1992 IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK FOR PURPOSE OF REVIEWING THE AUGUST PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT. CHAIRMAN DONER CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 7:30 A.M. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS WERE PRESENT.

ROLL CALL: JUDGE PAUL DONER, CHAIRMAN
BARBARA ALBERTSON, CO. CLERK
CAROLINE KROL, TREASURER

PURSUANT TO THE OPEN MEETING ACT, CHAIRMAN DONER OFFERED TO ACCEPT PUBLIC COMMENT. AS NO ONE WISHED TO VOICE THEIR CONCERNS, CLERK ALBERTSON ASKED THAT THE COMMISSION PROCEED WITH REVIEW OF THE PRIMARY PROOF BALLOT AS PRESENTED.

CLERK ALBERTSON CITED MCLA 168.556 AND EXPLAINED WHY THERE WERE TWO ROLLS OF DEMOCRATIC CANDIDATES. ALSO STATED, THAT IN THE CITY AND TOWNSHIP WHEREBY THE 96TH STATE REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT WAS DESIGNATED, THAT TWO (2) ROLLS OF DEMOCRATIC & REPUBLICAN WOULD APPEAR.

AFTER EXAMINATION OF THE BALLOT, COMM. DONER MOVED TO APPROVE THE BALLOT AS PRESENTED BY THE CLERK. THE MOTION WAS SUPPORTED BY CAROLINE KROL AND THEN PASSED BY ROLL CALL VOTE OF 3 YEAS, 0 NAYS.

COMM. KROL MOVED THAT THE COUNTY CLERK BE AUTHORIZED TO HIRE THE NECESSARY PERSONNEL FOR ELECTION DAY AND EVENING ASSISTANCE. ALSO, TO FURTHER GRANT PAYMENT OF ANY EXPENSES INCURRED DURING THIS TIME. JUDGE DONER SUPPORTED THE MOTION FOR STAFF AND EXPENSES AS APPROVED BY UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE.

JUDGE DONER MOVED TO ADJOURN THE SESSION CALLED FOR BALLOT APPROVAL. CLERK ALBERTSON SUPPORTED THE ADJOURNEMENT AND THE MEETING CONCLUDED AT 7:55 A.M. BY UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE.
