

**NOTICE OF ELECTION
TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS
OF BAY COUNTY, MICHIGAN
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2017**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an Election will be held in the County of Bay, State of Michigan on Tuesday, November 7, 2017 at which time the following offices and proposals are to be voted for. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m to 8:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time.

Offices to be voted:

Bay City Commissioner Wards 1, 3, 5, 7, 9
Essexville City Council Member(s) - Full 4 Year Term
Essexville City Council Member - Partial 1 Year Term
Bay City Charter Commission Members

Proposals to be voted:

The following is a summary of two (2) ballot proposals which shall be considered by the electorate at the November 7, 2017 election.

Proposal 1: Bay County Medical Care Facility Millage Proposal (Countywide)

This is a continuation of the .75 of a mill previously approved by voters in 2012 that expires November 30, 2017. “Shall the limitation of the amount of property taxes which may be assessed each year against all taxable property in Bay County be increased by not more than .75 of a mill (.75 cents per \$1,000) for a period of 6 years, 2017-2022 inclusive, for the operation, maintenance and capital costs of the Bay Medical Care Facility?” This millage will raise estimated revenues of \$2,070,286 in the first year of the levy.

Proposal 2: Bay City Charter Revision (City of Bay City)

“Shall there be a general revision of the Charter of the City of Bay City?”
