THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS MET ON WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2016, IN THE OFFICE OF THE BAY COUNTY CLERK, ON THE FIRST FLOOR OF THE BAY COUNTY BUILDING. THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WAS TO CANVASS THE VOTES CAST DURING THE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2016. TOTAL VOTES: 1159. ONLY ONE TOTAL TAPE. OATHS ADMINISTERED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AT START AND CLOSE OF POLL. WRITE INS - SEVEN TOTAL, ONLY ONE VALID. EIGHT SPOILED BALLOTS ACCOUNTED FOR, AFFIDAVITS BUT VOTE WAS ACCOUNTED FOR. NO REMARKS IN POLL BOOK ABOUT AFFIDAVIT.

TOTAL VOTES: 1801. ADMINISTERED OATH, BUT ONLY ONE TOTALS TAPE PROVIDED. POLL WORKER ADMINISTERED OATH TO CHAIRPERSON. POLL WORKERS SIGNED AT BOTH OPEN AND CLOSE. POLL WORKER FAILED TO SIGN OATH. NO SIG OF CHAIRPERSON TO ELECTION INSPECTORS. CHAIRPERSON DID NOT LEAVE PERSONAL PHONE NUMBERS, TO BE CALLED TO COME AND SIGN. NO REMARKS IN POLL BOOK. EPB LIST OF VOTERS 1234. ONLY ONE LISTED AS A PROVISIONAL BALLOT SUMMARY DOES NOT REFLECT A DIFFERENCE. ONE WRITE IN FOR MCMULLIN. CHAIRPERSON CAME IN AND SIGNED TODAY 11-9. CITY CLERK WILL CALL ABOUT TWO VOTE DIFFERENCE.

**BAY CITY, WARD 3, PRECINCT 1**

ONLY ONE TOTALS TAPE. OATH ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AT START AND CLOSE OF POLLS. POLL BOOK POLL BOOK SHOWS 1080 VOTES AGREES WITH TOTALS TAPE. LIST OF VOTERS SHOWS 1082. POLL WORKERS WERE TOLD BY ANOTHER VOTER THAT A PERSON WALKED OFF WITH A BALLOT, TOTAL VOTE WAS RESOLVED. NO PROVISIONALS PROVIDED AND NO REMARKS. NO WRITE INS.

TOTAL VOTES: 1122. OATH ISSUED TO SIX AT START AND CLOSE OF POLLS. ONLY ONE TOTALS TAPE WAS PROVIDED. THERE WERE NO WRITE INS.

TOTAL VOTES: 1305. OATH ISSUED TO SIX AT START AND CLOSE OF POLLS. THERE WAS ONLY ONE TOTALS TAPE PROVIDED. BALLOT #618 WAS SPOILED BECAUSE THE PERSON WALKED OUT WITH THE BALLOT AND IT WAS NEVER TABULATED. THERE WERE NO WRITE INS.

TOTAL VOTES: 1151. OATH ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AT START AND CLOSE OF POLLS. THERE WAS ONLY ONE TOTALS TAPE PROVIDED. THERE WERE NO ISSUES AND NO WRITE INS.

**BAY CITY, WARD 7, PRECINCT 1**

TOTAL VOTES: 1296. THERE WAS NO SIGNATURE OF CHAIR ADMINISTERING OATH, OATH WAS ISSUED TO SIX POLL WORKERS AT START AND CLOSE OF POLLS. ONE WRITE IN FOR MCMULLIN AND ONE FOR JUERS. CHAIRMAN WILL COME IN TOMORROW TO SIGN THE POLL BOOK. LIST OF VOTERS: 1297 - TABULATOR: 1296. SPOILED BALLOTS: 26 YET TABULATOR READS: 27. CHAIRMAN WILL NEED TO EXPLAIN THE DISCREPANCY FROM THE LIST OF VOTERS TO PRINT OUT OF TABULATOR. CHAIRMAN CAME IN TODAY AT 3:35 PM TO SIGN AND EXPLAIN THE ABOVE. PER CHAIRMAN, THERE WERE TWO OF THE SAME BALLOT NUMBER. THERE IS NO CLEAR EXPLANATION THAT CAN BE FOUND, BUT TOTAL OF THE DAY COULD BE OFF BY ONE VOTE. ONE BALLOT MAY HAVE NOT BEEN ENTERED FOR REASONS UNKNOWN.

**BAY CITY, WARD 8, PRECINCT 1**

TOTAL VOTES: 1273. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AT THE START AND CLOSE OF POLLS. ONLY ONE TOTALS TAPE WAS ISSUED. THERE ARE NO SIGNATURES FOR ELECTION INSPECTOR REPUBLICAN OR DEMOCRAT. CALLED THE CHAIRPERSONS SPOUSE, SHE WILL PASS MESSAGE TO CHAIRMAN TO GET SIGNATURES. THERE WAS ONE WRITE IN FOR MCMULLIN AND ONE FOR JUERS.

**BAY CITY, WARD 9, PRECINCT 1**

TOTAL VOTES: 1289. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AT START AND CLOSE OF POLLS. THERE ARE TWO SUMMARY SHEETS INCLUDED, THE SECOND SHEET IS PRINTED. ONE HOUR AND 15 MINUTES LATER IS THE CORRECT ONE, THE DIFFERENCE IS IDENTIFIED IN THE REMARKS. THERE ARE NO REAL ISSUES. NO WRITE INS.

**BAY CITY BOARD 1 ABSENTEE VOTERS**

OATH ISSUED TO FOUR POLL WORKERS AT START AND CLOSE OF POLLS. WE FOUND DUPLICATE PAGES, THE ISSUES WERE RESOLVED. NO CONSOLIDATED TOTALS TAPE WAS PROVIDED. THERE WERE NO WRITE INS.

**BAY CITY BOARD 2 ABSENTEE VOTERS**

THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO THREE POLL WORKERS. ISSUES WITH PRECINCT SIX AND NINE; NOT ALL VOTERS THAT RETURNED BALLOTS ON ELECTION DAY WERE NOTED.

**CITY OF ESSEXVILLE PRECINCT 1**

TOTAL VOTES: 717. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AT OPEN AND ONLY THREE POLL WORKERS AT CLOSE. THERE WERE NO REMARKS AS TO WHY TWO POLL WORKERS WHO WERE THERE AT OPENING WERE NOT THERE AT POLL CLOSING. TWO TOTAL TAPES WERE GIVEN. THERE WERE NO WRITE INS. SUMMARY SHEET WAS OFF A TOTAL OF SEVEN VOTES. BOARD FOUND AND RECTIFIED THE VOTES IN THE REMARKS.

THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS ADJOURNED AT 4:50 PM ON NOVEMBER 9, 2016.

THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS RECONVENED ON NOVEMBER 10, 2016 AT 9:00 AM.

**CITY OF ESSEXVILLE PRECINCT 2**

TOTAL VOTES: 721. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO SIX POLL WORKERS AT OPENING OF POLLS AND TWO POLL WORKERS AT CLOSE OF POLLS. THERE WERE NO REMARKS AS TO WHY POLL WORKERS LEFT. WRONG NUMBER WAS PUT INTO THE COMPUTER FOR THE TOTAL NUMBER OF VOTERS. THERE WERE 729 PUT INTO THE NUMBER OF VOTERS NOT THE CORRECT NUMBER OF 721. THIS IS JUST A SMALL MATH ERROR, NO BIG ISSUES. THERE WERE NO WRITE INS.

**CITY OF ESSEXVILLE ABSENTEE VOTERS**

PRECINCT 1 - THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO FOUR POLL WORKERS AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF THE POLLS. THERE WAS NO CONSOLIDATED TOTALS TAPE. THERE WERE NO WRITE INS.

PRECINCT 2 - TOTAL TAPE READS 285; TOTAL VOTE IS 283. POSSIBLE PROBLEM COULD BE THAT TEST BALLOTS WERE NOT CLEARED BEFORE VOTING BEGAN, CHAIRPERSON SAID SHE CLEARED MACHINE WHEN QUESTIONED BY CANVASS BOARD MEMBER LORENTZ. CANVASS BOARD CALLED CLERK, SHE INDICATED THAT TWO VOTES WERE IN PRECINCT 1 AV AND NEEDED TO BE MOVED INTO PRECINCT 2 AV. AS A RESULT, PRECINCT 1 AV TOTAL IS TWO UNDER AND PRECINCT 2 AV IS OVER TWO.

**CITY OF PINCONNING**

TOTAL VOTES: 521. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO SIX POLL WORKERS AT START AND SIX POLL WORKERS AT CLOSE PER THE CHAIRPERSON. NOTE: DO NOT USE STAPLES

ON TOTALS TAPE FROM TABULATOR. THERE WERE NO WRITE INS. THE BALLOT PROPOSAL LANGUAGE IS NO LONGER REQUIRED IN POLL BOOK.

**BANGOR TOWNSHIP, PRECINCT 1**

TOTAL VOTES: 692. THE OATH ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF POLLS. THE BOARD FOUND NO MATTERS WHICH TO ADDRESS. FANTASTIC JOB.

**BANGOR TOWNSHIP, PRECINCT 2**

TOTAL VOTES: 899. THE OATH ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF POLLS. THE BOARD FOUND NO MATTERS WHICH TO ADDRESS. FANTASTIC JOB.

**BANGOR TOWNSHIP, PRECINCT 3**

TOTAL VOTES: 900. THE OATH ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF POLLS. THE BOARD FOUND NO MATTERS WHICH TO ADDRESS. TOTAL VOTES COUNTED 899, ONE VOTER REFUSED TO VOTE AFTER BALLOT WAS SPOILED. FANTASTIC JOB.

TOTAL VOTES: 726. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO SEVEN POLL WORKERS WITH CHAIR AT THE OPENING AND CLOSE OF POLLS. ALL OF THE WRITE IN VOTES DID NOT HAVE AN OFFICE LISTED FOR ANY CANDIDATES. THE BOARD CALLED THE CLERK AND SHE SPOKE WITH THE INSPECTORS WHO VERIFIED THE OFFICES FOR THE WRITE INS.

**BANGOR TOWNSHIP, PRECINCT 5**

TOTAL VOTES: 1214. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO FOUR POLL WORKERS AND THE CHAIR AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF POLLS. WRITE INS: MAILLETTE - 50, MCMULLIN - 2 VOTES. THE BOARD FOUND NO MATTERS WHICH TO ADDRESS. FANTASTIC JOB.

**BANGOR TOWNSHIP, PRECINCT 6**

TOTAL VOTES: 938. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS AND CHAIR AT THE OPEN AND CLOSE OF THE POLLS. ALL OF THE WRITE IN VOTES DID NOT HAVE AN OFFICE LISTED FOR ANY CANDIDATES. THE BOARD CALLED THE CLERK AND SHE SPOKE WITH THE INSPECTORS WHO VERIFIED THE OFFICES FOR THE WRITE INS.

THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS RECONVENED AT 1:15 PM ON NOVEMBER 10, 2016.

**BANGOR TOWNSHIP, ABSENTEE VOTES**

VOTES: AV 375 PLUS 1171 POLL. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO SIX POLL WORKERS AND

CHAIR AT THE OPENING AND CLOSE OF THE POLLS. THE WRITE IN VOTES: MALLETT - 151, MCMULLIN - 2, REEVES - 3, AND REICHMANN - 3 VOTES.

**BEAVER TOWNSHIP**

THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO FIVE POLL WORKERS PLUS THE CHAIRMAN AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF THE POLLS. THE BALLOT PROPOSAL LANGUAGE IS NOT NEEDED. THERE IS TO BE NO TAPE USED ON THE TOTALS TAPE, IT PEELS OFF THE INK AND THE CANVASSERS CANNOT READ THE NUMBERS. THERE WERE TWO PROVISIONAL BALLOTS AND FIVE SPOILED BALLOTS.

**BEAVER TOWNSHIP ABSENTEE VOTERS**

TOTAL VOTES: 375. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO THREE POLL WORKERS AND CHAIRMAN AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF THE POLLS. THE WRITE IN VOTES: MCMULLIN - 3 VOTES AND JUERS - 1 VOTE. THE BOARD NEEDS BALLOT SUMMARY FOR BOTH PRECINCTS. PLEASE SEPARATE FOR POLLS AND ABSENTEE VOTER COUNT.

**FRANKENLUST TOWNSHIP**

TOTAL VOTES: 1425. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO FOUR POLL WORKERS AND THE CHAIRMAN AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF POLLS. PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE ENVELOPES.

**FRANKENLUST TOWNSHIP, ABSENTEE VOTES**

VOTE COUNT: 721 TAB AND 719 VOTES CAST. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO THREE POLL WORKERS AND THE CHAIRPERSON AT THE OPENING AND CLOSING OF POLLS. THE VOTE IS OFF BY TWO VOTES FROM TOTALS TAPE TO VOTER COUNT, ITS EITHER 2 DECEASED PEOPLE OR THE TWO SPOILED BALLOTS THAT WERE NOT FOUND. MATT CALLED THE CLERK, CHAIRPERSON AND TOLD TWO DECEASED PEOPLE.

**FRASER TOWNSHIP PRECINCT 1**

TOTAL VOTES: 1639. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO SIX POLL WORKERS AND CHAIRPERSON AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF THE POLLS. PLEASE DO NOT USE TAPE ON THE TOTAL TABULATOR TAPES. OFFICIAL CAN DOES NOT HAVE AN ID NUMBER, JURISDICTION OR A DATE ON THE STATEMENT OF VOTES. WE DO NOT NEED PROPOSAL LANGUAGE INCLUDED IN ENVELOPE. THERE WERE NO WRITE INS.

**GARFIELD TOWNSHIP**

THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO SIX POLL WORKERS AND THE CHAIRPERSON AT THE OPENING ONLY FOUR AT THE CLOSING OF POLLS, THIS WAS DOCUMENTED IN THE REMARKS AND ALL OK. PLEASE DO NOT USE TAPE ON TABULATOR TOTALS TAPE. IT TAKES THE INK OFF AND THE BOARD CANNOT READ THE NUMBERS.

PLEASE NOTE; SHOULD NOT ALLOW A PERSON TO VOTE WHO IS NOT A REGISTERED VOTER. THIS CAUSES CONFUSION BETWEEN FATHER AND SON, ONE WAS REGISTERED TO VOTE AND THE OTHER ONE WAS NOT BUT WAS STILL ALLOWED TO

VOTE ANYWAY. HENCE THE ONE VOTE OFF. ALSO, THE BALLOT STORAGE SEAL WAS INCORRECT. BOARD CALLED THE CHAIRPERSON WHO INDICATED THAT FOLLOW WORKER SEALED THE CONTAINER. WORKER CALLED; INDICATED THAT THE ORIGINAL SEAL WHICH IS REFLECTED IN THE POLL BOOK WAS DEFECTIVE, AND A NEW SEAL HAD TO BE USED. POLL WORKER UPDATED THE BALLOT CONTAINER CERTIFICATE BUT NOT THE POLL BOOK. AS A RESULT, ONLY THE BALLOT CONTAINER CERTIFICATE REFLECTS THE RIGHT SEAL NUMBER. THE BOARD ACCEPTED THIS EXPLANATION.

**GIBSON TOWNSHIP**

TOTAL VOTES: 571. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO THREE POLL WORKERS AND CHAIR PERSON AT OPEN AND CLOSE OF THE POLLS. PLEASE DO NOT USE TAPE ON TABULATOR TOTALS TAPE. IT TAKES THE INK OFF AND THE BOARD CANNOT READ THE NUMBERS. THERE WERE SIX SPOILED BALLOTS ON LIST OF VOTERS AND SEVEN ON THE SUMMARY SHEET. THERE WAS NO LIST OF VOTERS INCLUDED IN POLL BOOK. THE BOARD CALLED THE CLERK, THEY WILL BRING A PRINTED COPY OF VOTER LIST ON FRIDAY TO COUNTY CLERK AT 11:00 AM. VOTES LISTED AT 569 ON THE LIST, 570 ON SUMMARY AND TOP SHEET ONLY ONE TABULATOR TAPE. THE ONE DISCREPANCY IS VALIDATED IN REMARKS. NO WRITE IN VOTES.

THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS ADJOURNED AT 5:00 PM ON NOVEMBER 10, 2016.

THE BOARD RECONVENED AT 9AM ON NOVEMBER 14, 2016.

TOTAL VOTES: 443. THE OATH WAS ISSUED TO FOUR POLL WORKERS AT THE OPEN AND CLOSE OF THE POLLS. THERE WERE EIGHT SPOILED BALLOTS, AND NO WRITE IN VOTES. THERE WERE NO ISSUES TO RECORD.




