Please take notice that there will be three (3) Ballot Proposals for consideration:

- 1) City of Bay City, all voting precincts, for adoption of proposed City Charter.
- 2) City of Essexville, 2 voting precincts, general revision of the City Charter.
- 3) Reese School District, Merritt Township, an increase of levy not to exceed 1.5 mills (\$1.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of five (5) years, 2020 to 2024 inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites, construction/repair of school buildings, technology upgrades and other purposes to with revenue of \$369,900.00 to be collected in the first year of levy.

Full text of the ballot proposal(s) may be obtained from the City or Township Clerk. Sample ballots can also be found at [www.mi.gov/vote](http://www.mi.gov/vote).

Absentee ballots are available for all elections; registered voters may contact the local clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot. With passage of Proposal 3, a reason to request an absentee ballot, is no longer required. Voters may also request placement on the permanent absentee ballot list to receive ballots in future elections.

Passage of Proposal 3, required Clerks and/or their designee to offer a total of 8 office hours of service to the public on the weekend prior to election day. Contact the Clerk to determine the hours of operation for issuance of an absentee ballot on the weekend prior to election day.

To comply with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), voting instructions will be available in audio format and in Braille. Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternative formats can be made by contacting the City or Township Clerk in advance of the election. All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
