SEPTEMBER 11, 1992

THE BAY COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION MET ON FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 1992 FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVIEWING THE NOVEMBER 3, 1992 GENERAL ELECTION SAMPLE BALLOT. ALL MET IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK. THE MEETING BEGAN AT 7:30 A.M.

PRESENT WERE: BARBARA ALBERTSON, CLERK
 CAROLINE KROL, TREASURER
 BARBARA DUFRESNE, REG. OF DEEDS

ABSENT: PAUL N. DONER, PROBATE JUDGE

THE FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE BOARD, WAS THE TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT OF BARBARA DUFRESNE, BAY COUNTY REGISTER OF DEEDS. MS. DUFRESNE HAD AGREED TO FILL IN DUE TO THE ABSENCE OF JUDGE PAUL DONER.

CLERK ALBERTSON ASKED THAT THE COMMISSION MEMBERS REVIEW THE PROOF AS SUBMITTED TO THEM WHILE CHECKING FOR ANY ERRORS THEY MIGHT SIGHT.

AFTER A COMPLETE REVIEW OF THE BALLOT, IT WAS MOVED BY MS. KROL AND SUPPORTED BY MS. DUFRESNE THAT THE CLERK MAKE ANY NECESSARY CHANGES IN THE PROOF BALLOT AND THAT IT BE MAILED TO ALL CANDIDATES. MAILING TO TAKE PLACE SOAS TO ALLOW AMPLE TIME FOR THE CANDIDATE TO REVIEW THE PROFF AND REPORT ANY ERRORS BACK TO THE CLERK. MOTION CARRIED BY 3 YEAS, 0 NAYS.

THE NEXT ORDER OF BUSINESS INVOLVED THE QUESTION OF EXPENSES FOR THE ELECTION. EXPENSES WHICH WOULD INCLUDE THE PRINTING OF THE BALLOTS; SETTING OF VOTING MACHINES; PUBLICATIONS AND ANY NECESSARY SUPPLIES. MS. DUFRESNE MOVED THAT THE CLERK BE AUTHORIZED TO PROCEED WITH THE ELECTION AND THAT ALL NECESSARY EXPENSES BE APPROVED AND BE TAKEN FROM THE CLERK'S BUDGET LINE ITEM EXPENSES FOR ELECTIONS. MS. KROL SUPPORTED THE MOTION AS CARRIED BY UNANIMOUS VOICE VOTE.

BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD IT WAS MOVED BY KROL AND SUPPORTED BY DUFRESNE TO ADJOURN THE MEETING AT 8:10 A.M.
