Bay County, Michigan

You are hereby notified that at the General Election to be held in Bay County on Monday, the 6th day of April, A. D. 1931, the question of authorizing the Board of Supervisors of Bay County to borrow \$375,000.00 for the purpose of constructing and equipping a new Court House, will be submitted as authorized by the following resolution duly adopted by the Board of Supervisors at a regular session held January 24, 1931-  
VIZ:

## RESOLUTION

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors deem it expedient for the County of Bay or its lawful officers, agents and servants, to make or cause to be made a permanent improvement in said county by building and equipping a new Court House.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize and direct the borrowing or raising by loan on the faith and credit of the County of Bay the sum of three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000.00), to be used for the construction and equipment of a new Court House, and that bonds payable serially in thirteen annual installments of principal in amounts to be determined by this Board and bearing interest at the rate of four per cent (4%) per annum, payable semi-annually, be issued and sold, or issued and negotiated, to secure the re-payment of the sums borrowed or raised by said loan and to secure the payment of the indebtedness incurred in erecting and equipping said Court House; and

RESOLVED FURTHER, That a tax of one-half of one mill on the assessed valuation of Bay County be levied in the years 1938 to 1944, inclusive, for the purpose of paying the principal and interest upon the bonds herein provided for; and

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the tax of one-half mill on the assessed valuation of this County, now in effect under Act No. 14 of the Public Acts of the extra session of the Legislature of Michigan for 1926, be likewise used for that purpose.

Provided, however, that this resolution shall not become effective or binding upon Bay County until it shall be approved by a majority vote of the electors of this County voting thereon at the regular election to be held on the 6th day of April, 1931, under the general laws of the State of Michigan.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue and serve upon the several County and Township officers and to publish notice of said election, and to do all things necessary for the proper submission of said Resolution to the electors of said County at said election in accordance with the statute in such case made and provided.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the vote upon the proposition aforesaid shall be by ballot which shall be in the following form:
