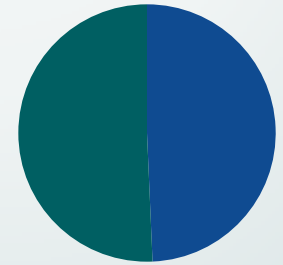

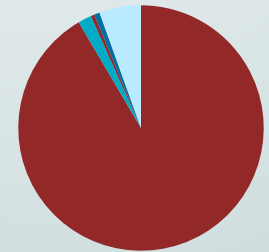

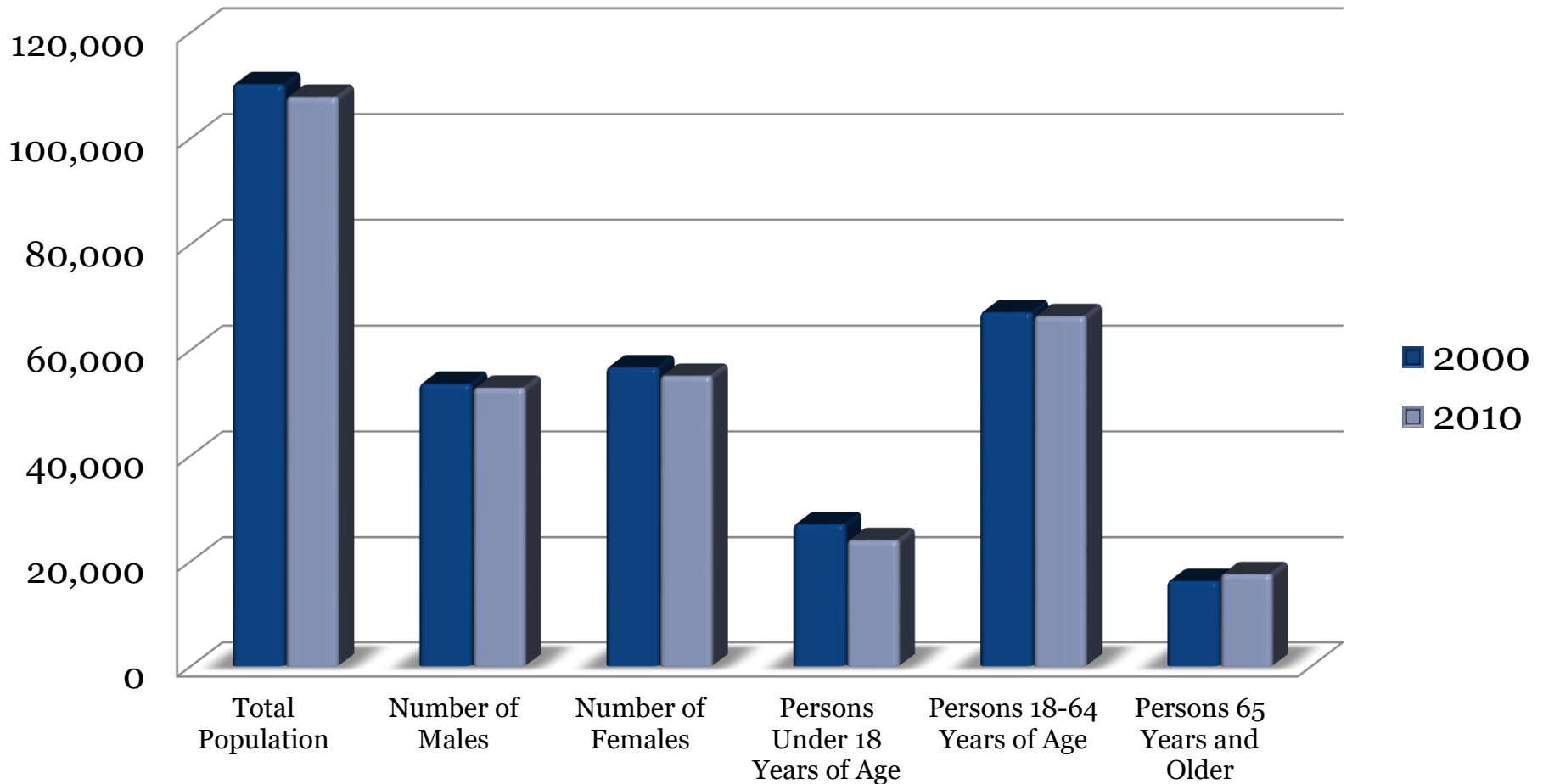

Population by Gender & Age

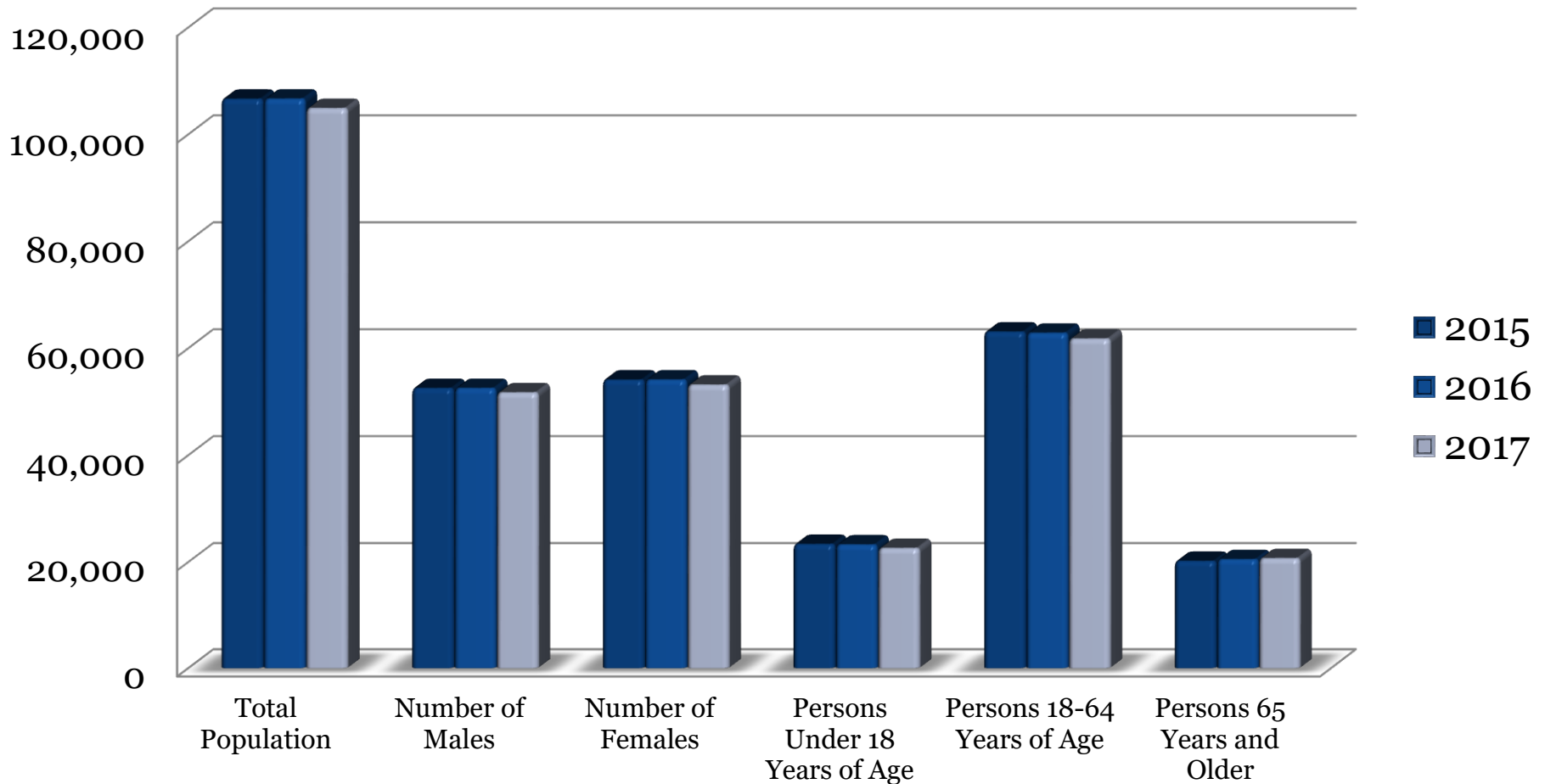

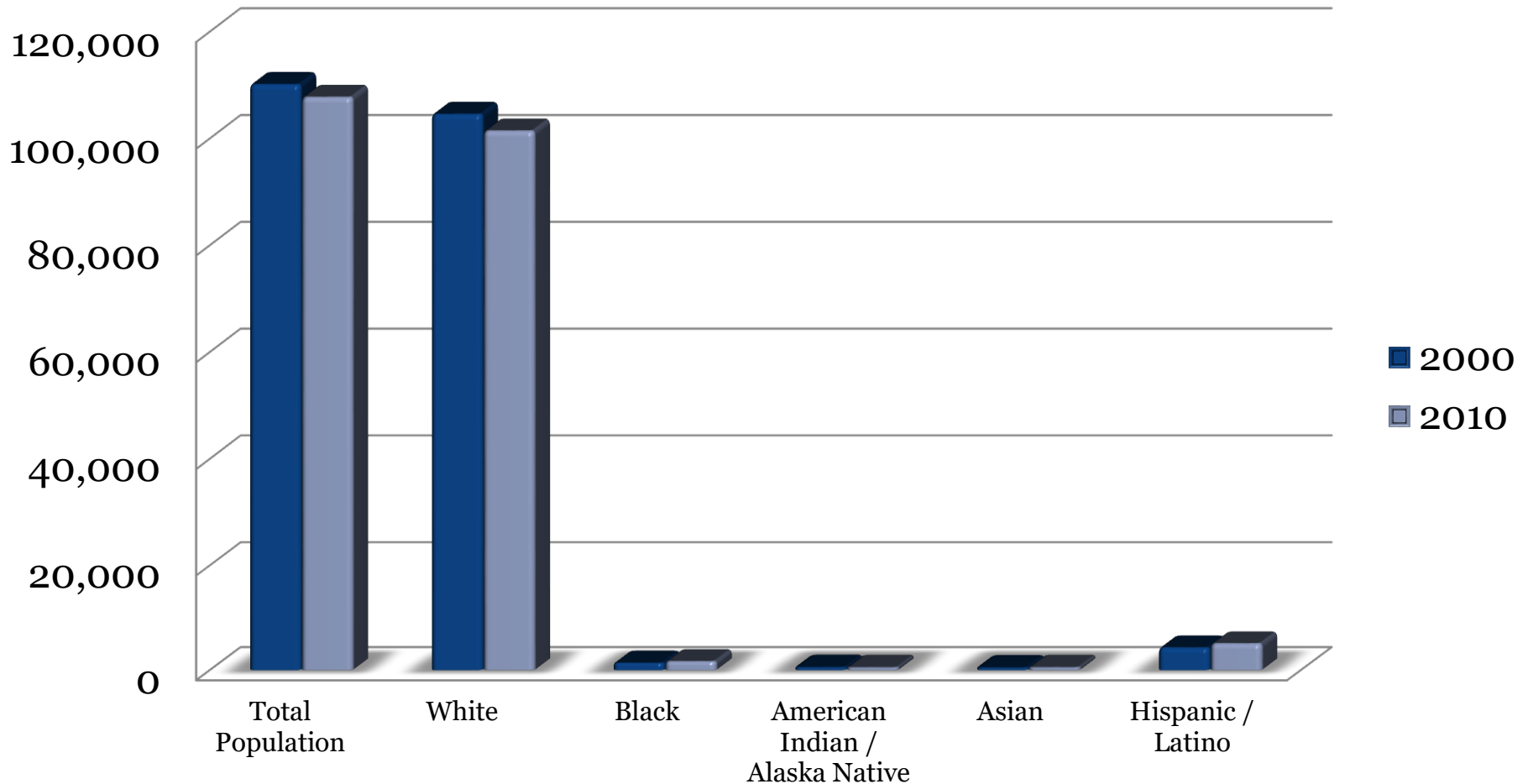

Population by Race/Ethnicity

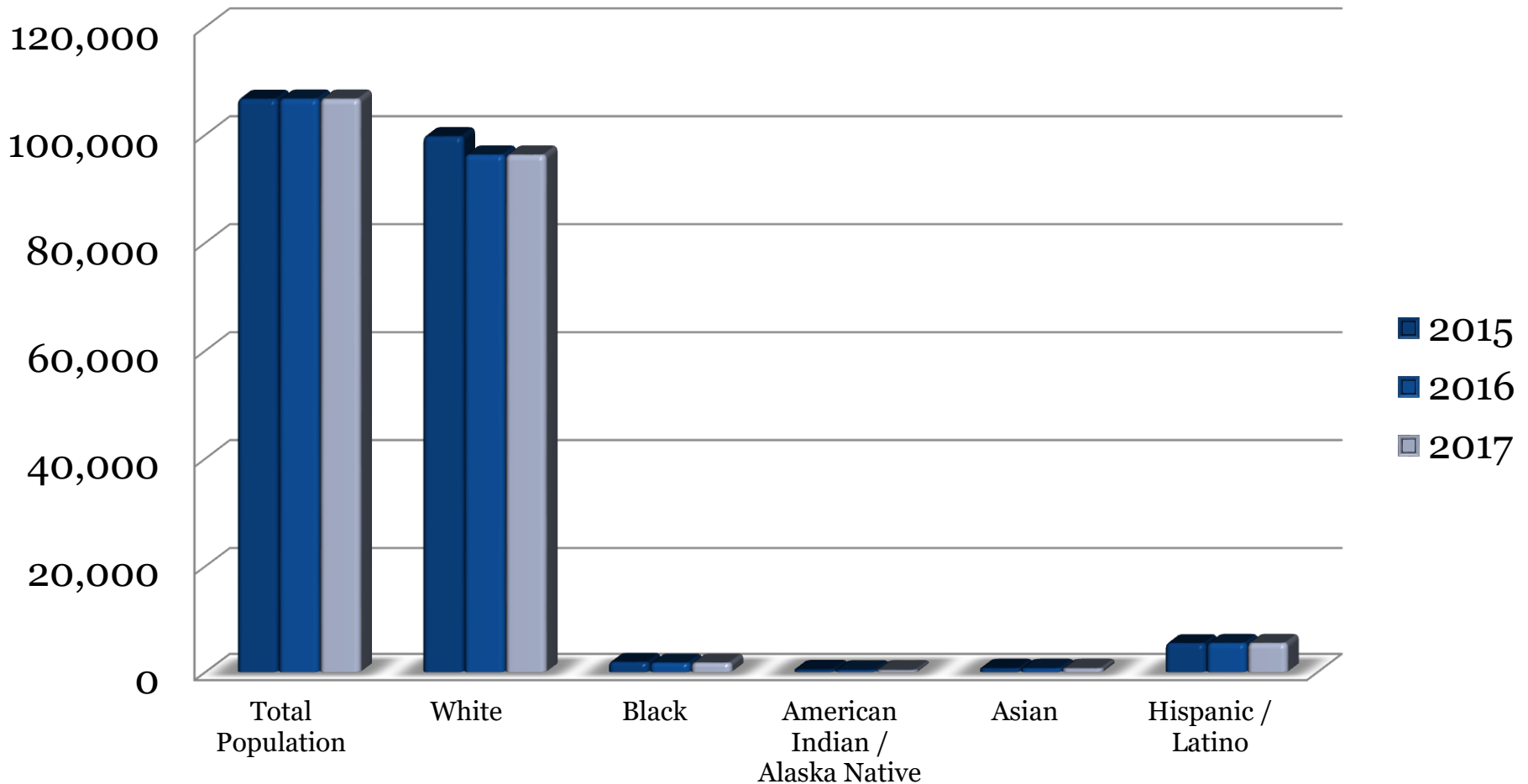

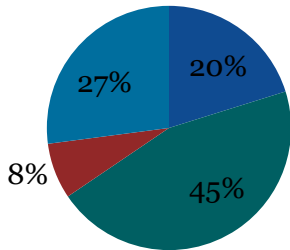

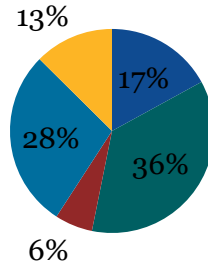

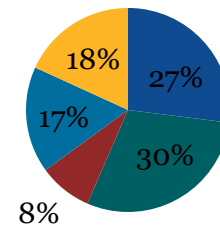

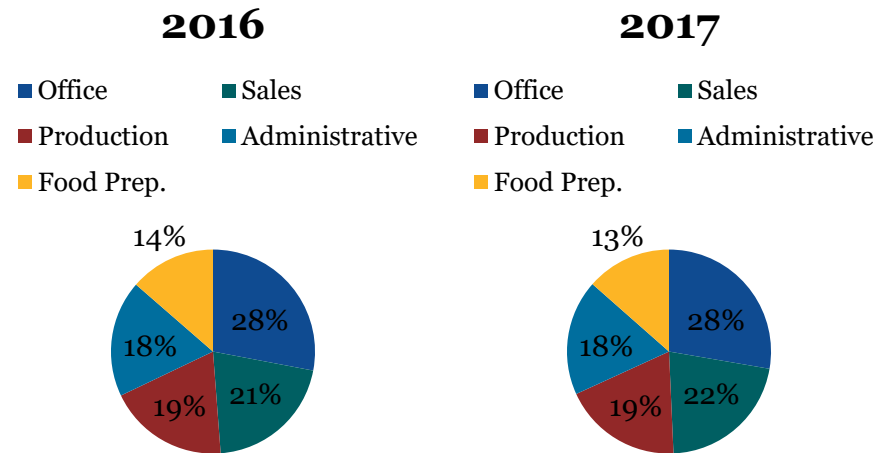

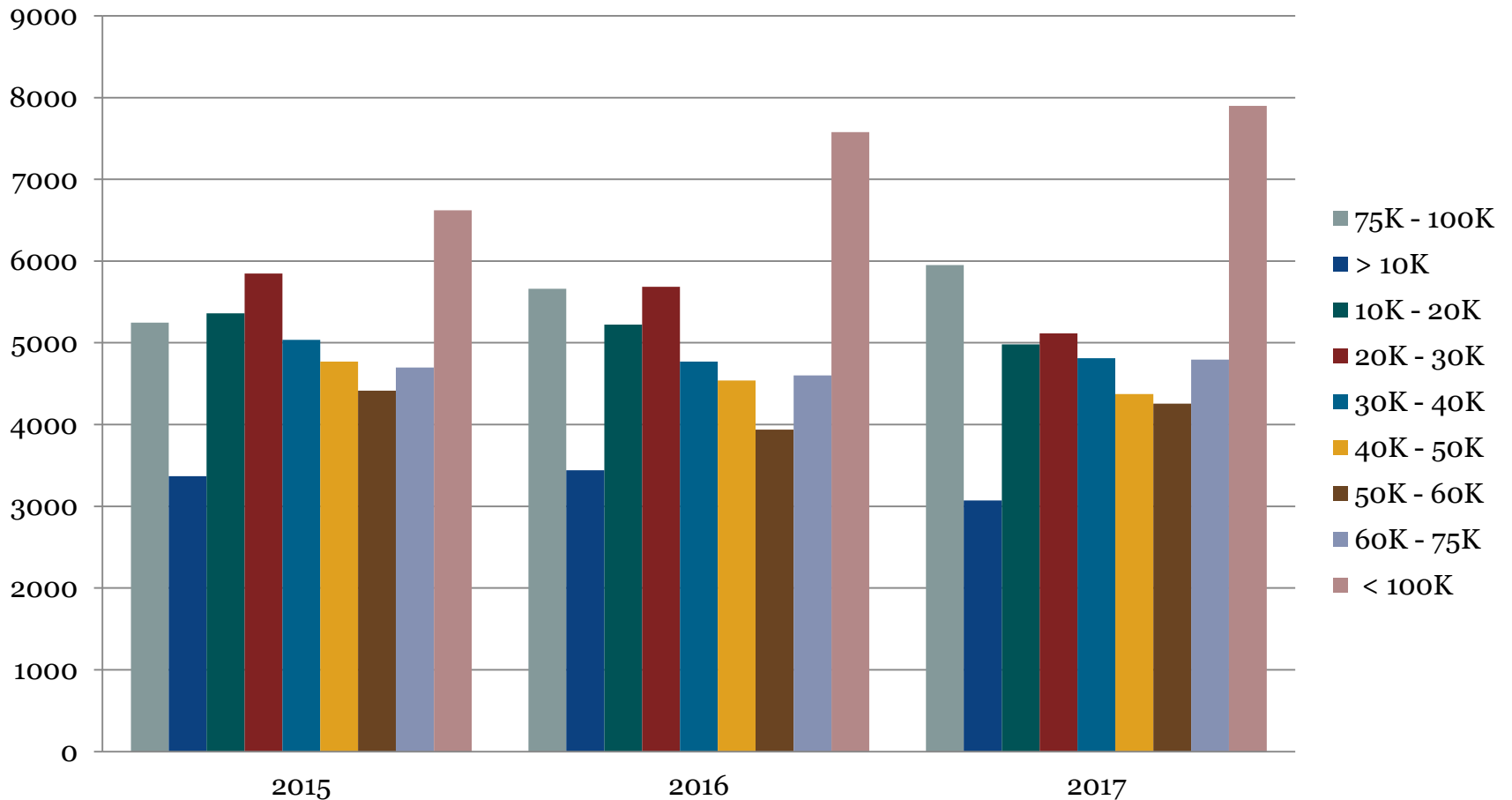
