

SEASONAL JOB VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT – MOSQUITO CONTROL

JOB TITLE: SEASONAL ADULTICIDE TECHNICIAN (NIGHT SHIFT)

**RATE OF PAY: \$10.65 per hour (1ST YEAR)
\$11.15 per hour (2ND YEAR)
\$11.40 per hour (3RD YEAR)**

GENERAL SUMMARY:

As a Seasonal Adulticide Technician, tasks will be performed as assigned by Bay County Mosquito Control supervisory staff relating to the surveillance and control of mosquitoes in Bay County. The ability to present verbal and written information on treatment and surveillance is necessary. The Seasonal Adulticide Technician will be required to operate and maintain Bay County Mosquito Control vehicles, and truck-mounted and hand-held equipment. Mainly, treatment will consist of driving a truck and applying control materials from a truck-mounted spray unit; however, from time to time, the seasonal adulticide technician may be asked to help treat ditches or other breeding habitats to control mosquito larvae. A workable knowledge of road maps, township plat maps, and familiarity with acres and distances is helpful. Hours and schedule may change during the treatment season of April 1 to September 30, but in general the schedule will be 7:45 p.m. to 1:45 a.m.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Apply insecticides according to instructions and training to control adult mosquitoes.
2. Operate truck-mounted larviciding and adulticiding equipment.
3. Complete detailed written records of all insecticide applications and other work performed.
4. Assist in preventative maintenance of vehicles, truck-mounted equipment, and held equipment, and buildings and grounds.
5. Deal with the public in a polite, courteous manner.
6. Consistent and punctual attendance is an essential function of this position.
7. Other duties as assigned by Supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS:

18 years old; high school graduate or equivalent; valid Michigan driver's license; must be able to be insured in accordance with the County's vehicle insurance carrier standards; must attend Bay County Mosquito Control's training session. **Must be able to pass a drug test and background check.**

GENERAL SUMMARY:

Will assist Mosquito Control Biologist in the collection and surveillance of mosquitoes in Bay County. Will identify mosquito larvae and adult mosquitoes using microscope and identification keys (training is provided). Will survey mosquito-breeding habitats, such as: sewage lagoons, roadside ditches, cross-country drains, woodlots, tires, etc. Will assist in landing counts, field tests of insecticides and equipment, quality control, etc. Good physical condition is required. A workable knowledge of road maps, township plat maps, and familiarity with acres and distances is helpful. Hours and schedule will be variable during treatment season of April 1 to September 30.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Collection of mosquitoes via larval surveys of breeding habitats, using baited traps for adult mosquitoes, and landing counts.
2. Identification in lab using microscope and keys.
3. Will assist in conducting field tests.
4. Will count and measure insecticide spray droplets on microscope slides.
5. Will help in taking blood samples from birds for encephalitis virus detection.
6. Will complete written reports/records of work performed.
7. Will assist in maintenance of vehicles, lab equipment, and buildings.
8. Consistent and punctual attendance is an essential function of this position.
9. Other duties as assigned by Biologist.

A large portion of treatment consists of ground application and surveillance that will require good physical condition. Hours and schedule will be variable during the treatment season of April 1 to September 30.

1. Apply insecticides according to instructions and training to mosquito breeding sites such as roadside ditches, catch basins, sewage lagoons, flooded woodlots, etc.
2. Operate truck-mounted larviciding and adulticiding equipment.
3. Complete detailed written records of all insecticide applications and other work performed.
4. Assist in preventative maintenance of vehicles, truck-mounted equipment, handheld equipment, and buildings and grounds.
5. Deal with the public in a polite, courteous manner.
6. Consistent and punctual attendance is an essential function of this position.
