**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a School Election will be held in the County of Bay, State of Michigan on Tuesday, February 24, 2015 at which time the following proposals are to be voted for. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m to 8:00 p.m. Eastern Standard Time.

**Essexville-Hampton Public Schools Proposals**

The following is a summary of the two (2) Essexville-Hampton Public Schools proposals which shall be considered on the February 24, 2015 ballot:

- I. Essexville-Hampton Public Schools general obligation unlimited tax bond proposal for building and site purposes in the amount of not to exceed \$4,970,000.
- II. Essexville-Hampton Public Schools sinking fund millage for building and site purposes 3 mills for 5 years.
